Pastor Joseph continued a 3-part series on "The Sermon on the Mount" with part 2 (from Matthew chapter 6). There are at least two different kinds of perfection; a divine perfection that only God attains to, and a lower level that refers simply to a human being whose current level of maturity and behavior means that their ways are pleasing in God's sight. The last verse of Matt. 5 seems to demand the former, making the Sermon on the Mount amazingly radical. The goal seems unattainable, yet we are still commanded to obey. We need to always strive for perfection. All the things we do, whether almsgiving, prayer, fasting, etc. must be for God's attention—not to be seen of men. We must lift up and praise the name of Jesus. Serving God must be our top priority in this life. We must do some things such as go to work or school, but we must take time for Jesus. Don't let anything in this life be your treasure. Store your treasures up in heaven. We can't serve both God and money. Worry not about material things in this life such as food and clothing. Trust God! Seek the things of God first! If our top priority is serving God, He will take care of us! Join us next Sunday for the conclusion (part 3).

Pastor Joseph preached "The Whirlwind" from Acts 2:1-4, 13:1-4 & II Kings 2:1-12. There was once a time in America when one could walk down the street without encountering nakedness. That's become rare in this perilous hour. Prayer has been taken out of our schools. Our land is full of people with upside-down thinking. Abortion, gender confusion, and same-sex marriage are being called "good." America has turned its back on God. Surely God's judgment is coming! In preparation, the godly person should be thankful that the Holy Ghost makes one separate (holy). We who have repented, been baptized in Jesus name, and have received the Holy Ghost are separate from worldliness. We must keep ourselves hungry for holiness and our mind focused on heavenly things. We must walk, talk, think, look and be different from the world. "Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world" (I John 2:15). The whirlwind is coming. Which side are you on? God can separate us—lift us out of this world—before His judgment comes.


