Pastor Joseph concluded a 3-part series on “The Sermon on the Mount” from Matthew chapter 7. The opening of this chapter is perhaps the most misquoted verse in all of Scripture. It is often taken out of context these days to claim that a Christian ought not have an opinion about anything that is not aligned with “politically correct” thinking. When taken in proper context, the Lord is actually teaching that we are to judge matters, only after judging ourselves first, and are especially required to judge fellow believers (help hold them accountable), but again, only after judging ourselves first. Since the church is the people, and all people have problems, the church on earth will always have problems. There is no perfect church down here, yet we are all striving for perfection. To judge is to form an opinion; to distinguish truth from falsehood. We need to judge ourselves and get right (clean our own life up). Then we will be able to rightly judge our brother/sister. It behooves us to live right. Treat others as you want others to treat you. Strait (narrow) is the gate and narrow is the way that leads to life. If you want your “house” to stand in the flood, obey the Lord Jesus; live right. Obedience to the will of God is what makes a true child of God. God is looking for a man who builds his house upon the rock—one who hears and obeys His Word.

Pastor Joseph preached “I Am” from Exodus 3:13-14, John 8:12-16 & Isaiah 44:24. “I AM” comes from Hebrew (YHWH, or Yahweh). “Jesus” (English) means “Yahweh-Savior” (“I AM-Salvation”). The *I Am* who led Moses in the Old Testament is *Jesus* in the New Testament. John’s gospel records seven great “I AM” statements by Jesus, such as, “**I am** the light of the world” (John 8:12). Whatever we truly need, the Lord says, “*I am—that.*” Jesus is Lord, the One who “formed thee from the womb, **I am** the Lord that maketh all things” (Isaiah 44:24). The man Christ Jesus said, “I am not alone, but I and the Father that sent me (John 8:14). Where the man Christ Jesus is, God is also. Jesus is God manifest in the flesh. God highly exalted the man Christ Jesus. “At the name of Jesus every knee should bow...and... every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, **to the glory of God the Father**” (Philippians 2:10-11).


Wednesday




