Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Power From On High" from Luke 24:49. We all need a personal encounter with Jesus, and we all need to obey the instructions of Jesus. We all need to partake of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. How can we obey the Gospel and be endowed with power from on high? The Lord Jesus taught repentance, water baptism, and Spirit infilling. The Apostle Peter summarized all the same steps of obedient faith, commanding: "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost" (Acts 2:38). In repentance we die to sin. In water baptism in Jesus name we are buried with Him. In receiving the promised baptism of the Holy Ghost, we are empowered to live a new lifestyle. Jesus told His disciples to tarry or wait for the promise. He said, "But ye shall receive power, after, that the Holy Ghost is come upon you" (Acts 1:8). In Acts the Spirit fell on each of them *individually* (it was not just a corporate event). Each one of us needs this experience and power. Furthermore, we must not let this experience be a mere memorial in yesteryear's events. This needs to be a fresh, ongoing experience!

When the prodigal son was on his way home, his father saw him afar off and was overjoyed that his son was coming home. God is our Heavenly Father. He seeks to save that which was lost. 


