Pentecost Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached a Pentecost Sunday message about experiencing the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, from Luke 24:49 & Acts 1:4-5. God is Holy, and He inhabits the praises of His people (Psalm 22:3). We are commanded to be holy (I Peter 1:16). If one is truly fed up with the sin burden, and he or she truly repents (which leads to a lifestyle change) that person may ask and God will give power to overcome sin, through the baptism of the Holy Ghost. One must be willing to depart from sin and press forward in their new life with Christ. "Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness; for they shall be filled" (Matthew 5:6). This process results in the believer having a new heart, led by God, through having God's law written in your heart. The Holy Ghost will give you power!

The world is trying to split churches. *God's true church stands together in unity*. We must obey the instructions of Jesus. We must be partakers of His death, burial, and resurrection. In repentance we die out to sin. In water baptism in Jesus name we are buried with Him. When we received the Holy Ghost, we are empowered to live a new lifestyle. The power of Pentecost is for today! It's for all believers! Note: we praise God for Bro. Garry Hedrick being filled with the Holy Ghost!
