Elder Lorren Godwin preached "My Brother's Keeper" from Galatians 6:1-3 & Genesis 4:9. We must consider others and show love. Although others sin and make mistakes, we cannot harden our hearts as if "they deserve it" when bad things happen to them. If we want mercy, we must also give mercy. We must not be afraid to ask for help/advice for fear of seeming weak. We all struggle with things. When others make mistakes, we should show love and not condemnation. Be your brother's keeper and face adversity together. While you are in church, be aware of others instead of letting you mind drift elsewhere. Someone may be in need. Be your brother's keeper by being attentive to their needs. Jesus showed love everywhere He went. He didn't condemn, but offered hope of repentance.

Pastor Joseph preached "3½" from Genesis 18:32-33, Deuteronomy 6:4-5, & Luke 16:14, 17:24-37. A crucial choice common to all mankind is whether to listen to God or to man. Some of the most murderous peoples in history were those who listened to man: Nazis, Communists, etc. Hitler used Darwinism to shape the view of Nazis so that killing others wasn't considered murder. They killed millions. Marx and Lennon (founders of Communism) also loved Darwinism and killed millions, as did Communists in the Orient. The culture in America today is rejecting nature (biology) and nature's God. Our age has begun to make the deliberate choice to listen to man instead of God. Yet with the Lord there is only one way! We must save ourselves from this "untoward" (confused) generation. Serve God with your whole heart. We must obey God and not man, when man's word contradicts God.

Wednesday


