Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Shepherd Stages, Part 2: Cycles of Life in the Kingdom of God" from Matthew 9:36-38 & 10:21-22. The Lord Jesus is both Lord & Lamb, both Sheep and Shepherd. When John saw Him, he said, "Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sins of the world" (John 1:19). Jesus was the sacrificial lamb. When Jesus died on the cross, He was the lamb dying and also the shepherd being smitten (Matthew 26:31). The Lord's servants are destined to be both leaders and lambs (guiding/shepherding lost souls and willing to suffer as sacrifices/martyrs). The Lord Jesus prophesied that we are to be persecuted and hated of all men for the name of Jesus. God will give us comfort in the midst of the battle. He will "make us complete" or bring us to maturity. We must stand for holiness – stand for what's right. Show the love of God to all men.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Beauty of Holiness" from II Chronicles 20:20-22. In the midst of battles we must sing praises to God. Jehoshaphat appointed singers unto the Lord and that they should praise the beauty of holiness. When they began to sing and to praise the Lord, God gave them victory. God is Holy; His Holiness is beautiful. We must be holy even as God is holy. We must abstain from every appearance of evil. Through repentance we put on the holiness of Christ. We are to have Jesus on the inside, which works a change on the outside as well. We will suffer persecution for the name of Jesus, but stand strong in your conviction with Jesus. Suffering is for a short time compared to eternity. When you're facing an army, praise God and He will fight for you. I will praise the "beauty of holiness."

Wednesday

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "Not Meant to Live Alone" from John 14:18. God loved us so much that He was willing to come in flesh, to die on the cross that we may obtain eternal life. God desires a close relationship with us. This relationship with Him is something we ought to work on continuously. We must pray, praise Him, fast, and witness to others about Him. Example: you don't just tell your spouse "I love you" once, on your wedding day. You tell them often. Make it a daily practice. The Lord promised that He would never leave or forsake us. This promise is a reference to the baptism of the Holy Ghost! Having His Spirit within us is crucial and essential for having a close relationship with the Lord. Elder Baron Claypool preached "The Mystery of God" from Isaiah 46:8-10. At some point in most peoples' lives they have questioned if God exists. All a person has to do is reach out to God and He will reveal Himself. In fact, all creation testifies to His handiwork so that we are without excuse. Since we know who God is, we should want so much of Him that others will see Him in us. Our faith and trust in God will allow us to combat the evil in this world. God is still revealing Himself today; in His Word, in nature – Just look around you!






