Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Church And Natural Israel" from Romans 10:1-13,21 & 11:1-4, 25-26. It should be the heart's desire of every Christian to see others saved. When God created mankind (Adam and Eve) He included genetic potential for great diversity in mankind, resulting in many varieties of people: fat and skinny, curly or straight haired, tall or short, and many possible shades of skin (black, brown, white, etc). All that variety comes from just two ancestors, one married couple: Adam and Eve. No matter what race you are from—Jew or Arab, Caucasian or Oriental, Asian or African, etc—we are all related to each other! Sadly, due to our sin curse, people tend to fear others who are "different." Often we exaggerate differences until we view a whole group of people with hate. Such hatred, anger, or animosity is wrong and sinful. A lot of the hatred and persecution of the Jews was done by people who called themselves Christians. Be very careful that you don't have any racist feelings about others. You may think you don't, yet something else slips out. "Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh" (Mat. 12:34). Jews are a chosen people, and salvation will be restored to them.

Sunday PM

Rev. Jonathan Sanders preached "Faith" from Hebrews 11:1-3,6. Fellowship is a type of exchange—that is, that we may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith. Many people think that they don't have faith because they don't know what faith is. We come together in fellowship to make an exchange of our faith through God and with each other. God has given each of us the same measure of faith. Faith is the affirmation and conviction that God exists. Faith takes a bit of imagination because things of faith can't be seen. Fear is vain imagination. We must be about "casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God" (II Cor. 10: 5). When you pray you must know that God hears and will help you. Sometimes God will allow your faith to die like a seed so that it may sprout and grow. We need to cry out to Him and discover that we have faith. Believe and pursue Him, and then, we shall be rewarded.

Elder Zach Sandy preached "My Daddy Can Take Your Daddy" from Hebrews 13:8. Jesus is still the same. He has not and will never change. The same One who created the heavens and the earth is the One who died on the cross for our sins. He is the One who raised Lazarus from the dead. He is the One who can heal diseases today. Jesus has all power. We can have that same power if we have the Holy Ghost. There is no limit to what to what we can do for God if we are obedient to Him. Pastor Joseph spoke briefly from John 5:19. Jesus was born as a human manifestation of the Spirit of God. The man Jesus was human in every way. Jesus was the union of Father and Son. "I and my Father are one" (John 10:30). He had great power. We can have that power if we have the Holy Ghost and are led by Him. God will give us direction the same way He gave direction to the man, Jesus.


