Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Do-over" from Joel 1:15, 2:1, 21-32, Acts 2:1-4 & I Cor. 6:9-11. The "Day of the LORD" in Scripture is from a Hebrew phrase, "Yom Yahweh," and it refers to a terrible time period of God's judgment. There have been several such times, including the Global Flood. However, a very terrible one, the Great Tribulation, is coming. However, Christians need not fear the coming of the Lord! We can be redeemed now, and look forward to His coming with joy! This calls for a New Birth experience. Every man, woman, boy and girl must have a spiritual "do-over" in their life. As was prophesied in Joel 2, God is pouring out His Spirit on all flesh. We were all born in sin; therefore, we must come to God, acknowledge our sin and let Him make us over again. No evildoers or anyone who hasn't been born again will inherit the kingdom of God. God's people had become dry; they had forsaken the God of the living water. Yet God promised there will be a temple in Israel again. Living water will flow from it. 
