Sunday — Sunday School Picnic, open-air service, & day at the park

Pastor Joseph preached from Acts 19:1-7. Today, quite a few church organizations and preachers hold a false view, which is to claim that every Christian believer has the Holy Ghost, since (as they claim) all believers instantly, invisibly, silently, and unknowably received the Spirit at the moment when they believed. Yet such a notion is clearly and easily disproved from the Bible. In our text, when Paul met some disciples at Ephesus he asked them “Have ye received the Holy Ghost *since ye believed?*” (Acts 19:2). Elsewhere, in Acts 8, the new converts in Samaria had heard Christ preached (v. 5), had believed (v. 12), had been baptized by immersion in water in Jesus name (vv. 12, 16), and had great joy (v. 8), but as yet the Holy Ghost had not yet fallen on a single one of them (v. 16)! The apostles which were at Jerusalem heard, and sent Peter and John, who laid hands on the people, and finally the Holy Ghost baptism was received. This it is a false doctrine to teach that people always automatically get the Spirit at the moment they believe! So this important question, “Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed?” (Acts 19:2), needs to be posed to everyone we meet. It is a crucial reason why we have designed multiple T-Shirts recently (for our church, for the Grafton church, and for the Fresh Oil Conference) all having this question on the back! God has given us faith to receive the Holy Ghost. The baptism of the Spirit is essential for our salvation. We don't have to beg and sweat to get it. This experience is a gift. All we have to do is receive by faith. Jesus said, “If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water” (John 7:37-38). Then John, the gospel writer, explained saying, “(But this spake he of the Spirit, **which they that believe on him should receive:** for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)” (John 7:39, emphasis added). If you are a *believer*, then you should be a *receiver* of the Spirit baptism! Don't wait! Receive the Spirit today!

Wednesday

Elder Rusty Sandy preached “Prepare Yourself” from I Corinthians 2:9-10. You must prepare yourself for the harvest and what God has in store for you. You must devote yourself to seeking God's face. Study His Word. Do not just read it, but study with a prayerful heart. Mediate upon it, absorb it, and then, apply it to your life. Be steadfast. Sing praises unto Him. Let serving God be your top priority in life. Have a close relationship with God so that nothing will be able to separate you from Him. David didn't need Saul's armor to fight against Goliath. He was a man after God's heart; he had prepared himself spiritually. Young people: follow in the steps of your elders. Obey and reverence your pastor.






