Elder Lorren Godwin preached "May I Have Your Attention Please" from Exodus 3:4. People are so preoccupied with gadgets (such as cell phones) that these are the first things they reach for when they go in a restaurant or get out of the car. We are so focused on *things* rather than *Jesus*. We get so worried about others' lives on social media that we don't focus on our own spiritual life. It is important to unplug and just fellowship with God. We need to focus on the *eternal* more than the *temporary* things. God had to set something on fire in order to get Moses' attention. Sometimes God will allow little "fires" happen in our lives to get our attention. We need to have personal time with God, a time when everything else can be shut out. SEEK HIM FIRST. "But seek ye first the kingdom of God and his righteousness…" (Matthew 6:33).

Rev. Ashley Vaughn preached "The Purpose Of The Ark" from Hebrews 11:7 & I Peter 3:20. We need to be a God-fearing people, just as Noah was. The church is our present-day ark. We must let God bring us into this place of safety and salvation. Don't bring the world's ways into God's church. We must build our life the way God specifies, like Noah built the ark according to God's design. Noah didn't know why the ark had to be so big or made only of gopher wood, yet he diligently obeyed God's will in his life. Sometimes God's will doesn't make sense to us, but we must trust Him and obey Him precisely. The ark had no steering rudders or anchors. As the ark floated, all Noah could do was trust God. We need to let go of things in our lives and let God have control. He will keep us safe. When Noah was through with his ordeal with the ark, he emerged to a new world. We can have that, as well, if we are faithful.
