#### **Sunday AM**

Pastor Joseph preached "Covenant Of The Heart" from Matthew 5:21-37. The concept of *covenant* is intertwined with the concept of *dispensation*. Throughout every dispensation, God has used a different approach to save man, but every time mankind has, on the whole, rejected God and refused His offer of help. Mankind, as a fallen, sin-cursed family, has a tendency to drift toward sin. Sinful people have done many immoral things in the past, yet often these things seemed "perfectly moral" *at the time*. Our generation is doing the same thing now with abortion. (The immoral practice of abortion *seems* moral to many today.) Sin is ingrained inside humans. We are all born with the sin curse. God has made a new covenant wherein He fills us with His Spirit and changes our hearts. "For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their minds, and write them in their hearts; and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people" (Hebrews 8:10). This dispensation, with the Holy Ghost baptism, is the best one yet. We need to hang onto this covenant. Be concerned that we don't lose out with God.

#### **Sunday PM**

Pastor Joseph preached "Blood Flow" from Leviticus 17:11 & I John 1: 7. There is eternal life purchased in the blood of Jesus. His blood is a sinless and pure source of life that cleanses us from all sin. We are redeemed by His blood. The church is His body and His blood flows through the body. Church discipline is sometimes needed to address a foreign agent or to help continue the blood flow. We are the body of Christ and our life-giving force is the blood of Jesus. We need to bind together and help one another so that the blood flow is not cut off, because if this happens, we will lose connection with God and each other. "I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in Him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing" (John 15:5).


### Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught "Tithes & Offerings" from Malachi 3:10-12 & 6-9. Abraham tithed out of faith. He did so before the Mosaic Law existed. To tithe is to give one tenth of your increase. An offering is to give out of your "abundance," after tithing. We are to be cheerful givers. We give, not because we are forced to, but because we want to. We should desire to give to God to see His Kingdom flourish. Elder Zach Sandy preached "God Is In Control" from Psalm 29:4-11. Almost nothing works out exactly how we wanted it to. We must look to the One who is always consistent in our life: God. He never changes. In stressful times when we feel that we are all alone, we can call on Jesus and know that He is always there. The Creator of the universe is and always will be in control.
