Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Freedom" from Proverbs 23:7. It is a blessing and an opportunity to be able to go to church. A born-again Christian has freedom from all worldly things. "My heart is fixed, O God, my heart is fixed; I will sing and give praise" (Psalm 57:7).



