True believers need not fear the endtime. Paul the Apostle said that he prefers "to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord" (II Corinthians 5:8). 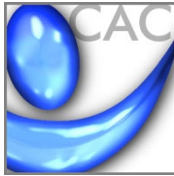

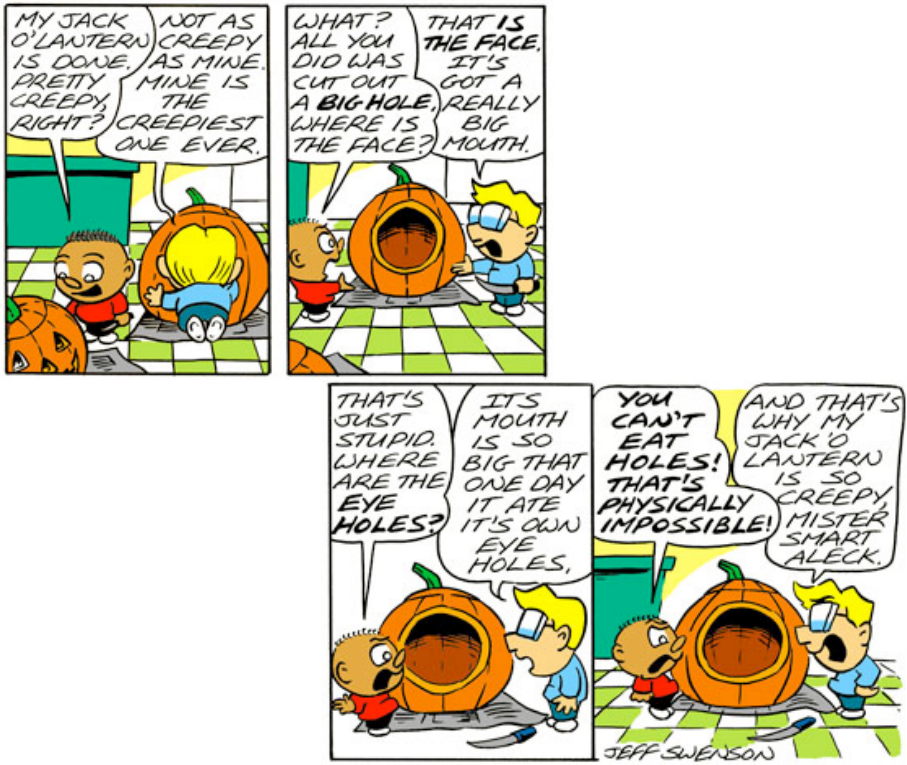
