Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught on "The Prophetic Law of Multiple Fulfillment" from Joel 2:1-3, 21-32 and Acts 2:12-21. Flawed methods of Bible interpretation lead to false doctrines, which can result in real world problems. One crucial example of this is when people read the Bible's prophecies without knowing about or understanding that God has clearly used a concept of multiple fulfillment, and thus they arrive at incorrect conclusions including a seriously inaccurate doctrine known as "Replacement Theology" (in which they think the Church has permanently "replaced" natural Israel and that God has forever rejected Israel). God will literally keep every unconditional promise He has made to Israel (such as Joel 2 and many, many others) notwithstanding the fact that the Church is blessed to get a secondary fulfillment in advance. In fact, even God's conditional promises are kept as well, with whichever pledge corresponds to the given conditions. Romans chapters 9, 10, and 11 make explicitly clear that God has not rejected natural Israel and that the Church has not "replaced" Israel. If God could ever break unconditional promises to natural Israel, that would make God a liar and none of His promises would be trustworthy. God is not a liar, and He will keep and fulfill every promise He has made. The Church should stand with Israel. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "My Portion" from Ezekiel 47:22-23, most of Ezekiel 48, all of Psalm 16, especially 5, 8-11, and Lamentations 3:21-24, 25-26, 31, 32, especially 24. During the Millennial Kingdom Age, each Jewish tribe of natural, mortal Israel will have a portion of the promised land for their inheritance, and Ezekiel 48 gives a carefully explained plan for the portions. Notably, the plan indicates the arrangement will be centered around "the Prince"—a reference to the Messiah, Jesus Christ. We are not Jewish and don't have a specified portion of land then, but the Scriptures lead us to conclude that the Lord Himself is our portion, and we know that regardless of when or where, He will take care of us as His people. When the Lord is present, manifesting the glory of God, all His creatures, whether human or angelic, mortal or immortal, look toward Him as the center of our attention, the object of our worship, and the focus of our hearts. Just as the oil flows through the Golden Candlestick known as the Menorah, the Spirit of Christ flows through the Church, making us alive with His glory and anointing. No matter what sickness or suffering we endure, nothing, not even death, can detract from our joy in knowing that He is our portion, and knowing that resurrection / change to immortality awaits us!




