Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Liberty In Spirit" from Romans 8:21. Liberty is not the freedom to do wrong, but the freedom to do right. Without help from God, none of us can actually be righteous. All men born in this world (except the Lord Jesus) are bound by the curse of sin. To overcome it, one must come to God, repent, be baptized in Jesus name, and be filled with the Spirit of God (Holy Ghost). Then one must continue daily being led by God's Spirit. We must seek to please God! The world calls evil good, such as men permitted into women restrooms and vice versa, same-sex "marriage," etc. We must stand strong and not back up on truth on moral issues such as sanctity of life and sanctity of marriage. It is real freedom to serve God. We have freedom of spirit. "Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty" (II Corinthians 3:17). "Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin" (John 8:34). Being a slave to sin is bondage. Jesus offers us spiritual freedom from the bondage of sin. Doing right is not bondage; it is true liberty.

Pastor Joseph preached "Gentile Bride" from Acts 10:44-48. Great men of God from ages past took Gentile brides: Boaz, Joseph, Moses, and more. Thankfully, the Lord Jesus also welcomes repentant Gentiles into His Bride, the Church. The Apostle Peter acknowledged, "God is no respecter of persons: But in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him." (Acts 10:34b-35). We must not boast ourselves against the Jews or be hateful toward them. We must not buy into the false doctrine of Replacement Theology. We ought to humbly realize that the unclean creatures in the vision God showed Peter in Acts 10, are symbolic of Gentiles—us! We ought to be thankful for forgiveness of sins and salvation. The Gentiles were once not a people in God's Kingdom. "Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God; which had nor obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy" (I Peter 2:10). God spoke of us in Isaiah 65. Only by the mercies of God are we saved. We had nothing and were going nowhere until the Lord bought us and grafted us in as a Gentile Bride.

Elder Hannah Sandy preached "What Are You Sowing?" from Galatians 6:7-10. If we would reap eternal life, we must sow to the Spirit, not to the flesh. We must treat others with goodness and kindness. We must reflect Christ in us to our neighbors and those we come into contact with each day. We must reach out to the lost to help as many as we can find their way to God. He that sows to the flesh shall reap corruption, but he that sows to the Spirit shall reap life everlasting. Elder Charles Hoskins preached "Don't Give Up On God, Don't Be Deceived" from Matthew 24:3-5. We must take heed and not be led astray by the many false winds of doctrine the world teaches. Keep a close relationship with God and obey His law. God's Word is pure. We must obey it. Do not be discouraged!

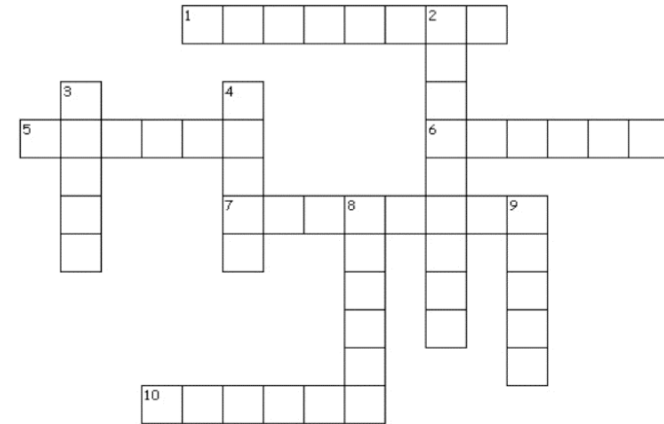

Thanksgiving Crossword



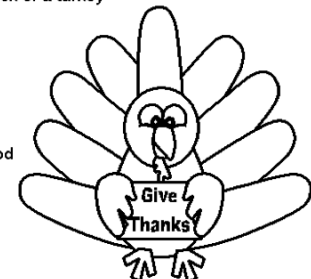

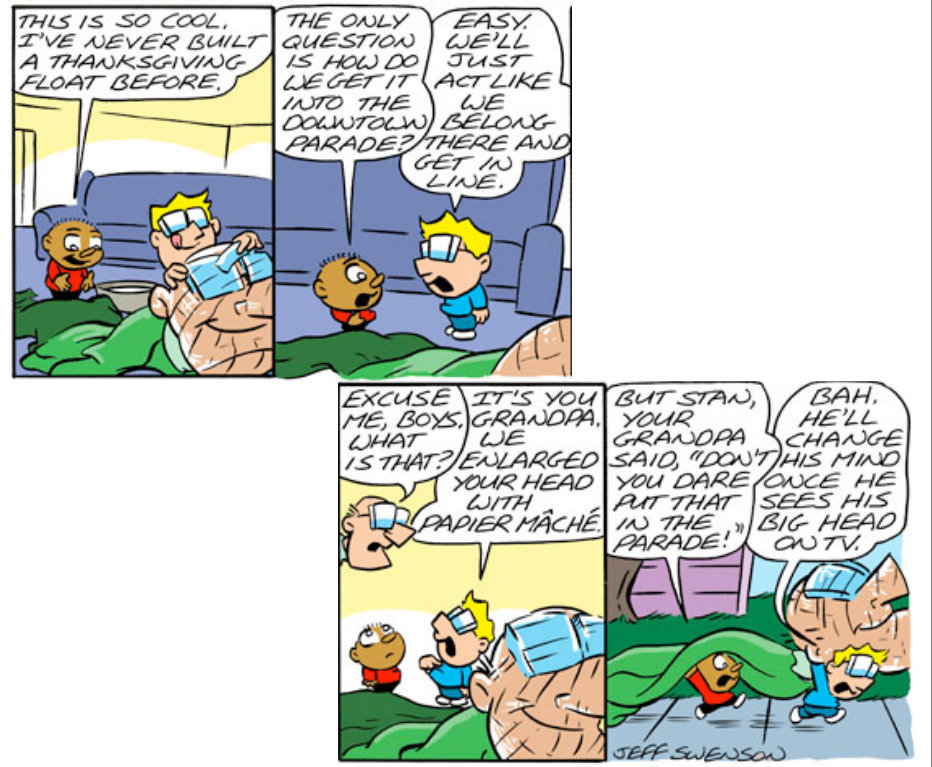

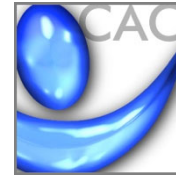
