Pastor Joseph preached "Joy In The Journey" from Deuteronomy 29:1-6. All the important choices in life will be made either in faith or in doubt. As believers, this one thing determines whether our time in this life will be "joy in the journey" or merely "welfare in the wilderness." Who is like unto God? As Moses and the children of Israel wandered through the wilderness for forty years, their clothes and shoes didn't wear out. Yet God viewed the people as being in two distinct groups: God cared for the older generation that had doubted and refused to enter Canaan, yet they were simply being allowed to grow old and die. God's care for them was actually a sort of "welfare." They would never see the promised land. However, the youths who were under "voting age" when the decision of doubt was made, were on their way to Canaan land. By faith they walked with God. We can have joy in our journey if we have faith. "Without faith it is impossible to please Him" (Hebrews 11:6). There is "the hope which is laid up for you in heaven" (Colossians 1:5). We know that if we are living a holy life for God, we have hope of an eternal life in heaven. God wants us to be "spiritually healthy." When the "holiness movement" started, it was strong, but it gradually declined. We must be on guard and pass the love of truth on to the next generation. Walk in truth! Keep the faith! Hold fast to truth! A life of faith & holiness is a life filled with joy.

Pastor Joseph preached "The Day Of The Lord" from I Thessalonians 5:1-11 and several other passages. "Yom Yahweh" is whenever the Lord comes in strong judgment for mankind's sin. It is actually a period of time rather than a 24-hour day. At such times, God typically concludes one "age" and establishes another. God's Word foretells a terrible "Yom Yahweh" ahead of us, and as wicked as the world is now, the day must be near. We need to examine ourselves regarding our level of holiness in daily living. There is no room to compromise with the world. No one can "earn" his or her way into Heaven through good works. One must be filled with the Holy Ghost and keep a close relationship with God. Everything we do should be for Jesus. We must live a holy life. Jesus is coming for His bride, "a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing... holy and without blemish" (Ephesians 5:27). The Day of the Lord is at hand. He is coming for those who are living a holy life separated from the world. We must be ready! He is coming with wrath and mighty judgment to those who don't know Him.


Tuesday


