Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Kingdom Minded" from Matthew 5:3. "Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 5:3). The phrase "poor in spirit" seems to refer to those who have sacrificed their own goals for what is right in the kingdom of God. We must crucify our flesh. Our mindset should be toward the kingdom. The Apostle Paul exhorted "I die daily" (I Corinthians 15:31). We must die out to carnal desires and allow God to guide our lives. This is how we walk in the Spirit and not in the flesh. We must decrease and He must increase. We ought to promote Jesus, not self. The call is to rid ourselves of anything that distracts us spiritually or comes between God and us, as in the example of the F.I.S.H. acronym (First I Seek Him). The devil will try to destroy our relationship with God, but he can't if we are "kingdom minded." We must focus our entire life on God. When we do this, then "for us to live is for Christ to live," for He lives within us, and we become instruments of His will.
