Pastor Joseph preached "The Principal Thing" from Proverbs 4:5-7 & Mark 12:28-31. Wisdom, which is to know God's will in any given situation and then obey it, is the greatest trait a person can have. It is the principal (main) thing. Jesus is the principal (head or main person) of the Church. God is united with the man Christ Jesus as one. In Christ Jesus dwells all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. We must live a principle-based life. Sin always complicates things. Sometimes sin will cause godly principles to be at odds with each other, yet wisdom can determine which issue is "the main thing." We must honor God first. Ten principles of godly living are: (1) Worship only one God, (2) Love your neighbour, (3) Be humble, (4) Be honest, (5) Live a morale life, (6) Be generous with your time and money, (7) Practice what you preach, (8) Don't be self-righteous, (9) Don't hold a grudge and (10) Forgive others. Live your life to "do good" not just to "feel good." It's more than what we say, but also what we do that matters. Jesus is our reason for living.

Pastor Joseph preached "Help For The Tin Man" from Ezekiel 36:26-27, Joel 2:28-32 & Acts 2:1-4. In the children's novel, *Wizard of Oz*, the tin man desired a heart. The core issue with all unredeemed people is they need a new heart. Many wrongfully think government laws or political policies can truly fix things for people, but the only help for mankind is God. Each soul needs the baptism of the Holy Ghost, by which God takes away our stony heart and gives us a heart of flesh. People are broken and need a heart change. Governing the wicked usually leads to oppressive laws and loss of freedom. Yet restrictions and heaviness of the government will not fix the sin problem. Instead of the government controlling man, men need to turn to God. Jesus is the answer. Let Him remove your heart of stone and keep it from ever hardening again! Church makes a difference in life.


Wednesday
