Pastor Joseph preached "BBQ Faith" from Luke 9:62. Each and every believer is called to serve in God's kingdom. Quick success is not a confirmation that we are in God's will, and even a steady lack of success does not mean we are out of His will. BBQ meat is best when cooked "Low & Slow" —meaning cooked at a low temperature for a long time. Our walk with God is comparable to that. Quick success ought not be the goal. We have a lifetime of lessons to learn. God wants us to keep serving Him patiently, caring for people, regardless of success or failure. We need to mature until we can stay faithful, resist depression, and give a lifetime of service. Many people start their walk with God, then grow weary and give up because they thought success was supposed to come quickly. We must keep going forward in our walk with God. "And let us not be weary in well doing; for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not" (Galatians 6: 9). Jeremiah preached to the people and they would not hear him, yet he fainted not. At one point he almost fainted. He decided not to preach anymore, but God's Word was "as a burning fire shut up in my bones" (Jeremiah 20:9), so he had to let it out and preach again. He didn't see success but he stayed faithful to the end. We must stay faithful in our walk with God. Never give up!


Wednesday
