Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught part 1 of an expository series titled "Old School" from Exodus 22:1-14. This passage covers various legalities of protection of property for the Hebrews living in a theocracy under Mosaic Law. However, the passage's teachings are pertinent today not only for the God-inspired logic of the various protections and disincentives to discourage theft and embezzling, but also for the undeniable fact that woven into the very fabric of the Word of God is a bedrock concept of the validity of human ownership of private property. In today's wayward culture, with the societal and governmental acceptance of the foolish and dangerous concept of socialism somehow gaining ground, it is increasingly important for Christians to be able to explain and defend the godly, valid concepts of ownership of private property and free enterprise capitalism, which are supportable from the Word of God.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached about every believer having a ministry of "servant leadership" using Matthew 19:13-14 and Matthew 20:20-28 as his text. He also included anointed preaching about the New Birth experience, reading John 3:3-5 aloud and reciting Acts 2:1-4 and Acts 2:38. Due to Adam's sin, all human beings (except Jesus) inherited a sinful nature (i.e. sin curse) and we are all conceived and born in need of redemption. The disciples, regardless of having been personally mentored by Jesus, were still often wrong-headed in their thinking prior to their conversion and their moment of Pentecost (when they were filled with the Holy Ghost). Of many incidents of their prior wrong-headedness, two were in the text passages in Matthew: rebuking children away from Jesus, and trying to get Jesus to promise them status and honor. Ministry is, and always has been, about selfless sacrifice and service to others. He that would be the greatest among us, let him be the servant of all. We have heroes among us who genuinely have a servant's heart. We should strive to emulate them and the Lord Jesus in this.

Wednesday

Elder Kieran Joseph preached "Step Up" From Genesis 3:17-18 & Proverbs 6:6-8. God doesn't like laziness. We must work to get something accomplished for God's kingdom in life. Being a hard worker reflects well on our reputation. People rely on those who are reliable. We will reap what we sow. God cares about what we do and how we do it. There is a time to work and a time to "chill." God rested after His work, and we ought to follow His example of working 6 days and then resting. Elder Rusty Sandy preached "This Means War" from II Corinthians 10:3-5. We are in a war against spiritual wickedness, not against flesh and blood. The devil goes about like a roaring lion, trying to take control of our lives. We must cast away all the temptations that the devil throws at us. Realize that he is trying to tear us down. Wage war against him. Stand strong in the Lord with the full armour of God. We must use our daily prayer life to seek the face of God. Imagine what would happen if we would seek the face of God!
