Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Have You Been Taken Captive?" from Genesis 47:1-3 & Exodus 1:7-13. We are no longer slaves. We've been set free. We must not let ourselves get entangled again in bondage. When we become more worried about what the world thinks of us than what God thinks, we become a slave to the things of this world. We get so wrapped up in chains, scared about what the world thinks. There are so many things that can take us captive: fear, doubt, unbelief, anger, and jealousy, to name a few. Don't listen to the devil. He may tell you that God doesn't love you and you're a failure. He is a liar. Take that thought straight to God and claim victory in your life. What are you letting hold you captive? We must cast aside every thought that does not come into obedience to the Word of God. Stand fast in the liberty where Christ has made you free.

She went to fetch Elisha and prepared for the boy's resurrection, not his funeral. We shouldn't focus on the bad circumstances around us. Rather, trust in the words of the King. "Where the word of a king is, there is power." When God speaks, there is immutable power in His promises! So, don't get bogged down by the way things look now. Hang on and victory will be yours.

Elder J.T. Sandy preached "There Are Giants Among Us" from I Samuel 16:6-13 & 17:48-50. We as people look on outward appearances. We judge both matters and people by our limited human perspective, but God looks at the heart. Even though David was young in stature, he had a heart for God, and with on his side, he was the real giant, not Goliath. David had a heart that was set on doing the things of God.
