### Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph continued the "Old School" expository series, focusing on Exodus 22:16-25. Some Bible verses tolerate certain sins/crimes, regulating & discouraging through penalties, while over verses stipulate a death penalty for other crimes. Thus, even a cursory look at the Bible debunks a notion that "all sins are equal in God's eyes." Regarding regulating evil: Because God foreknew that heart-hearted humans would do evil, some parts of His Word are meant to regulate evil to limit it (e.g. verses regulating slavery). Such are not an endorsement of the evil. We would always prefer to abolish evils such as abortion, but until we can convince enough people to do so, laws regulating abortion are often the best paths to saving more lives. Thus we attempt to regulate an immoral practice while also trying to stop it altogether. This is why "West Virginians For Life" members rally to ban dismemberment abortions and any killing of a preborn child who can feel pain. These efforts are all done while trying to abolish abortion. Pithy points: God views our spiritual relationship to Him like a marriage; if we let anything become more important than God, it is spiritual adultery. Don't mistreat widows and orphans. When lending money to a fellow believer, refrain from charging him interest.

## Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Repent" from Hebrews 10:19-27, 35-38 & II Peter 3:5-9. God grants us free will, but evil choices will not be tolerated forever. The Day of the Lord will come! God will bring destruction and judgment of the wicked and the unbelieving. He made provision for all men to come to repentance but if they exercise their God-given option to refuse, they will eventually meet destruction. The first worldwide destruction was by water. The second will be by fire, but it won't destroy the righteous, just as the Flood did not destroy Noah. Moses saw a burning bush that wasn't consumed. We can be like that bush: not destroyed by the coming fire. The way of salvation is to repent, be baptized in Jesus name, receive the Holy Ghost, and then live a holy life. We must stay fully focused on God. Our old lifestyle must die and be buried. We must stay on fire for the Lord. If we are lukewarm—neither cold nor hot—He will spew us out of His mouth (Rev 3:16). We must take stock of our thought life as well as movies, music, wardrobe, etc. Be completely sold out to God. Above all else, we must be saved!

## Wednesday

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "Seek God, Obey God" from Heb. 11:7 & Mat. 6:33. It is of great importance that we seek God in everything that we do. Get God's approval whether you're getting married or getting a job. Seek God, and then obey whatever He says. We can't follow our heart because our own heart is deceitful & wicked. We can't follow our dreams unless they are God-inspired dreams. We must seek God. He must be No. 1 in our life. We must build our "boat" exactly as God has directed during prayer, fasting, & Bible study. We should stay away from people and things that would corrupt our minds. Be totally committed to God.
