#### Sunday AM

Elder Lorren Godwin preached "God Is My Refuge" from Joshua 20:7-9. Under Mosaic Law in Israel there were to be designated Cities of Refuge where a person who had accidentally committed a serious crime could seek refuge and be safe from those attempting to take revenge. We who have been washed in the blood of Jesus Christ have a refuge in Him, our Lord. Satan goes about like a roaring lion trying to lure us out of our refuge. We must be careful. Too often someone will look outside the church and think how wonderful it would be to do whatever they want without authority. We must resist the devil when he tricks us. He will have to flee. As long as we stand fast in our faith, we have protection and safety in Jesus. We must keep a made-up mind that we will stay in the presence of God. Be a captive of Jesus. Contrary to what the world's ideas are, "captive," in this sense, is not being in shackles. The captivity of God is safety, protection, and a free mind.

### Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "BBQ Faith, Part 2" from II Corinthians 5:6-10, 6:1-13, and Romans 14:16-23. God revealed Himself in flesh as Jesus, who lived a sinless life. He died for us, taking the sins of the world upon Himself. Jesus was the perfect sacrifice for us. We need to live our lives in such a way that we present our bodies a living sacrifice unto the Lord. A believer's goal is to be found acceptable and pleasing to the Lord. Thus we should desire to live as we "ought" to-per biblical instruction, while comparing ourselves to Christ's perfection rather than among each other. Jesus paid everything for us. We must live holy and be acceptable to Him. He lived to serve all men. Just as BBO meat is best when cooked at a low and slow temperature, our life-course of development in maturity is a long, slow process that takes much time. We must therefore be patient with others, and we even need patience for ourselves (Luke 21:19). We must keep our focus on both holiness and pursuing peace, so as to get along with people. One ought to judge self more than others. The first murder happened because men couldn't get along with each other. Let us lay aside our differences and get along with our fellow man. "If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men" (Romans 12:18).


### Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught a Bible study about the Marriage Supper of the Lamb, detailing some interesting points about the Endtime, such as the Tribulation, the multiple installments comprising the "First Resurrection," compared to the "General Resurrection" to follow after the Millennial Kingdom age (1000-year period). The First Resurrection seems to have three installments. The resurrection of Jesus, and immediately afterward, was a first installment when Old Testament saints arose (Mat. 27). Then the New Testament Church-Age saints will be raised next (in the Rapture). Finally, Revelation 20 indicates that martyred (beheaded) Tribulation-Age saints will be resurrected at the end of the Tribulation period, which is going to be very terrible. Stay prayed up and ready for the Rapture!


