Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught from I Corinthians 11. Paul exhorted believers to follow him as he followed Christ. There is a chain of command for authority/submission: the head of every man is Christ, the head of the woman is the man, and the head of Christ is God. Biblically, one reveals either rebellion or submission by their hair practices. Male believers who are under authority avoid practicing *komao* (a Greek verb meaning "to let the hair grow," often translated as "have long hair") while believing women who are under authority will practice *komao* (let the hair grow). Such women are "covered" with kome, a Greek noun that refers to uncut hair, sometimes defined as "full head of hair." (Note: a generic Greek term for hair, thrix, is available when a writer doesn't seek to specify uncut hair. Paul used kome instead.) For a man to "have long hair" (i.e. head covered by letting hair grow) dishonors his head (Christ), while a woman with cut hair (i.e. head uncovered) dishonors her head (father or husband). Rebellion brings dishonor. God created male and female at the beginning. For this cause a women ought to have power on her head because of the angels. Submission must be a decision of the heart. Her *kome* (uncut hair) is given her for a covering. Even nature teaches us that it is a shame for a man to have long hair. The churches of God have no such shaming.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "When I See The Blood" from II Kings 3:1-15 & Romans 6:1-11. Oh, what boundless love! Oh, the precious blood of Jesus! Only the blood of Jesus, the sinless One, can take away our sins. His blood is applied to our life when we are obedient to His word by being baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. The sins we have committed in the past are forgiven. Don't allow your past to have dominion over you. You've come up out of that watery grave to walk in newness of life. The Israelites killed a lamb and sprinkled its blood over their doorposts so they wouldn't be destroyed. It still takes the blood. Jesus is our sacrificial lamb. We must come to Him and be obedient to Him. When we repent and are baptized, we become dead to sin. We must offer our bodies, our thoughts, our dreams—our everything—to God, with obedient faith, unto righteousness.

Wednesday


