Elder Lorren Godwin preached "The Sound Of A Going" from II Samuel 5:24. When a platoon marches in formation, everyone must be in unison; everything must be in harmony. It is important for us as followers of Christ to be of one mind and one accord. We must stay connected to God and have a close relationship with Him. When we are in service we must keep our mind on God and not think about happened today or what is going to happen tomorrow. When we come to God in fellowship we must do it together as a team of believers. We must work together. Not working as one can cause discord and separation among brethren. We must speak the same thing and have the same mind. Keep a godly attitude so others can see a difference in you. We don't need a bracelet or t-shirt to proclaim it for us. If we stay connected with God He will shine through us. The sound of a going is the sound of marching. Marching is walking in unison.

Pastor Joseph preached "Abundant Life" from John 10:6-11. Blood speaks to God. God told Cain, "Listen! Your brother's blood cries out to me from the ground" (Genesis 4:10). The writer of Hebrews noted that Jesus' blood speaks "better things" than that of Abel's blood. The blood of Abel says, "avenge my murder." The blood of Jesus says, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do." As people, we often naturally tend to contrast ourselves with the most vile, evil, or wicked. Yet Hebrews did not contrast the blood of Jesus to Cain, but rather to the "innocent" Abel—whose blood fell short in that comparison. Don't compare yourselves to other sin-cursed humans. We need to compare ourselves to Jesus and realize how incredibly flawed we actually are. We are all a broken and hurting people. Trespasses and trials can literally rewrite our DNA and scar us emotionally. Many have a concept that such damage is permanent, and dwell on who is to blame. We need to change our attitude from assigning blame to seeking the Healer. Have faith in God. Jesus can rewrite our DNA and heal our hearts and emotions. He can take the sin curse from us and give us abundant life!

Bro. Matt Anderson spoke on "Put The Glass Down" from Genesis 27:38-41. Holding a grudge can be stressful. It is like holding a glass of water. At first it's easy to do, but the longer you hold the glass the heavier it gets. Finally it will only be bothersome to you. Don't carry a grudge. Instead give your offenses to God. Jr. Elder Kieran Joseph preached "Savior" from Isaiah 59:1. There is nowhere you can go that God doesn't hear your prayer. There is no situation you find yourself in that God can't help you. Sin, however, can separate you from Him. God is holy and perfect; therefore He can't dwell in sin. The old covenant foreshadowed the perfection of Jesus Christ. We needed the perfect sacrifice of our Savior, Jesus Christ, to fix Adam's sin.
