#### Sunday AM - Pentecost Sunday

Bishop Dan Garlitz preached "Average Is Not Enough" from II Kings 2:9-10. There used to be a time when an average person with an average job could expect an average lifestyle. ## Friday


Rev. Brian Norman preached "The Way: It Begins and Ends With a Choice" from James 1:13-15. Each of us will make a choice in our life that will determine the


