Rev. Brian Norman preached "I Prayed Through" from Titus 3:3-5. To have revival a church must have people who have prayed through and are living their lives submitted to God. "Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit" (John 12:24). Wheat must fall to the ground and die before it produces grain. We must die to the desires of this world and follow Jesus. To have revival we must get in our closets and pray. We must pray fervently. Fervent means to have intense feeling and enthusiasm for something. We are praying for lost and dying souls to be saved. You must **pray through**. When you pray through you gain strength. If you have never prayed through you will become an anemic Christian. Prayer is not where we bring our problems to God. It is where we bring God to our problems.

Rev. Brian Norman preached "The 10th Spiritual Gift" from I Samuel 3:1-5. The shepherd will hold a newborn lamb to his chest until their heartbeats synchronize. A sheep bonds with its shepherd. It knows his voice and won't follow any other. When God called to young Samuel, God's voice sounded like that of Eli, Samuel's pastor. May we hear God's word in our pastor's voice! The 10th spiritual gift is our pastor. Revelation 2 and 3 describes a pastor as "the angel of the church." Often God speaks to us through the pastor He has given us. Pastors care for our soul. Pastors are there for us when we are in need of prayer. They are the watchers of our soul. They pray for us even when we don't know it. They are in the community sharing the gospel in person.

Wednesday

Jr. Elder Kieran Joseph preached "It's Gonna Be Alright" from I Peter 5:7-8. God blesses both just and unjust with rain and sunshine. Everyone will have both good times and problems, but in tough times we must cast our cares upon the Lord, trusting that it's going to be all right. The devil seeks those he *may* devour— "may" indicated Satan must get God's permission to touch us (c.f. Job). Even then, God will work it all out for good and we trust that "it's gonna be alright." Elder Charles Hoskins preached "God Is Coming For Your Words" from Matthew 9:20-22. Without faith it is impossible to please God. Faith comes in a "right-now" inspired word from God. We need to anchor ourselves in faith. There is power in our words. Speak words of faith—they are life. When we pray, it gets God's attention. God is coming for your words.
