Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Something New" from Isaiah 43:18-21. Jesus said that his followers shall do greater works than He did (John 14:12). We can't focus on what Jesus said is "to come" if we don't *look ahead*. We must step out of our surroundings and reach out to souls. We must share with others our testimony of what Jesus has done for us. "You reap what you sow" means your actions all have consequences. We will reap whatever effort and attitude we have sown. We need to share this gospel and lift up Jesus. God said His Word will not return unto Him void (Isaiah 55:11). We have what this world needs—and that is hope. We have hope in Jesus! There are huge revivals happening around the globe. Focus on blessings that we are receiving. Look to the blessings that can happen and focus on accomplishing what God has called us to do. "Remember not the former things" (Isaiah 43). God wants to give us something new. Let's look forward to the future!

For the oncoming Memorial Day, Pastor Joseph preached a deliberately untitled message from Joshua 4:1-9 & Isaiah 52:13-53:5. He tied the namelessness of the sermon to the unknown soldier (and gave history of the memorial *Tomb of the Unknowns* in DC) as well as relating it to the memorial for a nameless "unknown god" in Acts 17. It is a grievous fact that the horrors of war can leave a soldier's corpse unidentified. It is even more saddening that the one true God and Savior should remain unknown to scores of lost souls. Let us not leave them unaware of his glorious name—JESUS! Isaiah's prophecy reveals two "suffering servants"—the nation of Israel, and (from among them) the Messiah (the Lord Jesus). Many soldiers suffered and died as servants, yet are unknown (unrecognized). We must keep the name of Jesus sacred and make sure others know His name and His sacrifice for mankind. We must let others know why our "would be" memorial (His tomb) is empty. Just as stones from the Jordan formed a memorial in Joshua 4, we are to be "lively stones" forming a memorial unto the Lord Jesus Christ!

Jr. Elder J.T. Sandy preached "The Sound Of The Trumpet" from Joel 2:1-3, Psalm 96:11-13 & Revelation 8:2. In the Old Testament, trumpets were used to call the people to assembly, to call to battle or a celebration or announce victory. In the future, a trumpet will sound when Jesus Christ comes in the sky to catch away His Bride, the church, upward to heaven! What rejoicing there will be! Let us prepare as if that day is today! Let us live ready to meet Him when He comes! Elder Hannah Sandy preached "The Desires Of Your Heart" from Isaiah 38:1-5. Be careful what you ask for! Sometimes we repeatedly cry out to God for things we want, but which He knows aren't the best for us. Sometimes, He will let us have these things in order to let us learn a lesson. Sometimes when God answers prayers, many will even abandon Him. It is our job to help these people by praying and reaching out to them. May we seek first His Kingdom, and His will, above all.

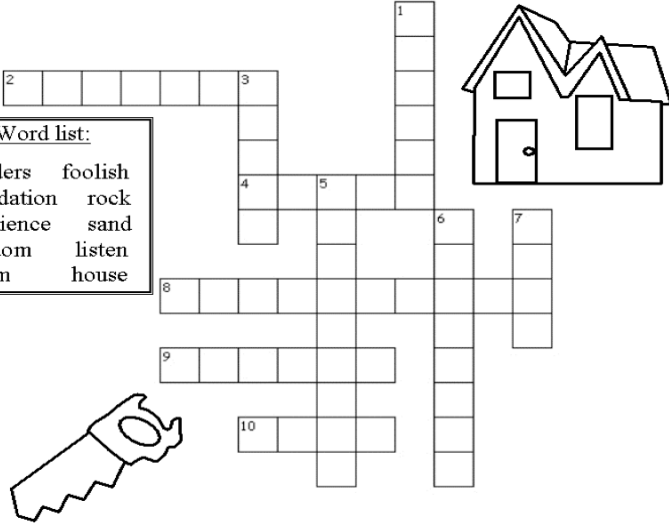

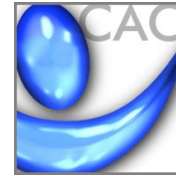
