Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Today I Shall" from Psalm 118:24. Too many of us let our worry about tomorrow rob us of our joy and victory today. We get frustrated and worry about things that will never happen. When you come to the house of God, seek an encounter with God. When the service seems dull and not as "on fire" as you like, YOU can give more praise. Raise your hands and worship God. Some of the things that people get mad about and leave church over, don't matter at all. Don't let someone's attitude pull you away from God. We must be determined to live in faith and not in fear. Live for God wholeheartedly. We must give ourselves totally to God. Today is the day that I will live for God! Today is the day that I will take a stand! Today is the day that I shall change my attitude! Grab a hold of God and don't let go. Let today be the day that your life changes.

Pastor Joseph preached "Stand" from Job 23:8-10, Ephesians 6:13-14 & Revelation 2:24-25. Through God's strength within us we can love Him during the bad times as well as the good times. If you've lost loved ones, mobility, ability and had your dreams taken away, you can find your purpose and sense of self by just holding on and trusting God. Do not blame your tragedies on God. Be like Job. He lost his children and earthly possessions, yet he said, "Though he slay me, yet will I trust in him" (Job 13:15). He wasn't bitter. In the midst of all his troubles Job worshipped and praised God. We don't have to obsess about what we're going to wear or eat. God will supply. When your life seems out of control, trust Him. When you don't understand, trust Him. When you think that you can't stand, trust Him and stand. In His strength we can do all things (Phil. 4:13).

Jr. Elder JT Sandy preached "A Generation of Whatever's" from Luke 17:11-19. "Whatever" is often used to mean one doesn't care. Nine of the lepers said "whatever" and went home. Because of this they were only cleansed of leprosy while the one who returned to say "thank you" to Jesus was made whole. We need to do *whatever* it takes to serve God with our all. We need the mindset of Job who lost everything. He served God no matter what happened to him. Change your "whatever" to "whatever it takes."
Elder Lorren Godwin preached "My Hero" from Job 1:22. When Job lost everything he owned, he didn't sin or blame it on God. He realized that God was ultimately in control. The first thing the devil took from Job was his sacrifices. The devil will try to take what you use to connect with God. He will try to take you away from church and your relationship with God. He will try to destroy your worship. We must take a stand and live for God no matter what happens to us. When Job was struck with boils, sitting in ashes, scraping his sores, his wife wanted him to curse God and die. His friends accused him. Still Job remained faithful to God. Let God be your hero. He loves us and is worthy of our worship.




