### Sunday AM – A message commemorating Independence Day

Pastor Joseph preached “Free Indeed” from John 8:36. Our rights come from God, not the government. We need to exercise our freedoms—including speaking out and voting. President Roosevelt Franklin spoke of four freedoms while addressing Congress on January 6, 1941: (1) **Freedom of worship:** Worship is much more than physical praise kept within a church building’s four walls; it is living your life fully devoted to God, even outside of church. This freedom is the basis for all others, and one’s attempts to exercise it properly will reveal one’s great need of a Savior. One who is born again has true freedom to do what is right. (2) **Freedom of speech:** We must speak the truth in love. (3) **Freedom from want:** “The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want” (Psalm 23:1). We must follow Jesus and eschew sin. God will supply all our needs. (4) **Freedom from fear:** Having a true relationship with God will make us free from fear. Jesus Christ can set you free. When you receive His Spirit, you will be free indeed.

### Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached “He Knows” from Psalm 121:1-8. “I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help” (Psalm 121:1). Lifting up our eyes acknowledges the One Who created us. We can’t see God, but we can see His works of creation. God knows us. He knows where we are. He knows what we’re going through. Look up and remember Who created all things. We serve the God Who created the universe. No enemy can stand before Him. He sees and understands all things. God is consistently present to provide strength to the weary and power to the weak. With this renewed energy we can soar on wings like eagles and run without wearing down. Lift up your eyes and be restored!

### Wednesday

Youth Pastor Rusty Sandy preached “A Generation Of Davids” from I Timothy 4:12. We are blessed to be in a church where the youth use their talents for the Lord. Some sing; some play musical instruments; some preach God’s Word; all of them praise the Lord with all their might. We must encourage the youth; love and support them. To the youth: You must have a prayer life. You have the energy to praise God and create an atmosphere of worship. Let God lead you. 




