### Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Power From On High" from Luke 24:44-49. Before Jesus went away He promised that He would send power from on high. Luke 24:44-49 is the synoptic parallel to Matthew 28:18-20. Repentance and water baptism are to be preached and conducted in Jesus name. There is no other name by which men must be saved (Acts 4:12). There is no other doctrine that should be taught other than the doctrine of the Lord Jesus Christ (I Timothy 1:3). Jesus told His disciples to go to Jerusalem and tarry until they were endued with power from on high. Acts 2:1-4 is the fulfillment. This was when the Holy Ghost—power from on high—was poured out upon the disciples. The Holy Ghost is God breathing life in us. On the day of Pentecost there were three signs. There were: the sound of wind, the cloven tongues of fire, and the speaking with other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance. According to Jesus, there must be sound when we receive the Holy Ghost (see John 3:8). We speak in other tongues as they did when the Holy Ghost was first poured out. Those who have made themselves ready will be at the marriage supper of the Lamb. We must be clothed in the garment of righteousness. "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost" (Acts 2:38). God is willing for all people, whether rich or poor, educated or ignorant, to come unto Him and receive power from on high.

### Wednesday

Elder Brian Murphy Jr. preached "There Is A Rock In The River" from Joshua 4:1-24. The twelve stones in the Jordan River were a memorial of when God had rolled back the waters. Rahab had heard of the miracles that God had performed for the Israelites. She believed His promises would be fulfilled and that there was no way of escape but by submitting to Him. Much like the stones in the Jordan River, she could use her past as a positive reminder of where she came from. The scarlet ribbon she hung in her windows (foreshadowing the blood of Jesus) makes us to remember that *there is a rock in the river*. We have an altar. Rahab didn't deserve God's goodness. Accord to the law she should have been put to death. She was a sinner saved by grace. The grace of God can save even the worst of sinners.

### Special update on Bishop David Hudson / Cora Irby

**Both Pastor & Sis. Joseph and Bishop Dan Garlitz have had lengthy visits with Bishop and Sis. Hudson.** Bro. Hudson is home-bound and under hospice care. He is fairly mobile, though he must use a walker to get around. He looks good and sounds good, however he has stated that he is at the end of himself, and if he does not get a miracle soon, he does not know how much longer he can last. He is immensely grateful for all our prayers and intercession before the throne, knowing that only those prayers have made it possible for him to have now survived into his ninth month of this unthinkable ordeal. He has done everything humanly possible to seek help (both chemo and alternative treatments, the latter of which are not paid for by insurance, and he has had to take \$70,000 from his retirement to try to pay for it). He knows nothing more to do but try to get through each day. The stress and duress of this ordeal has weighed heavily on Sis. Hudson, and she has suffered some ministrokes and other challenges. They both are at their limits over it all, yet they remain steadfast in their trust in God, stating He has all power and their faith in Him is not shaken. This week Sis. Hudson tendered to the District Board her resignation from serving as Ladies Ministries President. The board accepted with regret, honoring them both, and officially asking the Ladies Secretary, Sis. Zimmerman, to serve as acting president until the next Spring Conference, and to represent WV at General Conference, on behalf of Sis. Hudson. Bishop Hudson has lost approximately 70 pounds.


