#### **Sunday AM**

Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Bloody Coats" from Genesis 37:3-32. Joseph's father was only shown a coat, yet believed Joseph was dead. He saw one sign and became distraught. Often we see one sign of disaster, and we are quick to believe the worst. Don't get upset when something bad happens. It's just *life*. Joseph was sold into slavery and later thrown in prison. Through it all, he remained faithful to God and kept his attitude right. Sometimes you can't understand how situations will work out. Keep praying and stay focused on God. When it's God's time, everything will work out. "Casting all your care upon him, for he careth for you" (I Peter 5:7). Turn your cares over to God and He will work them out. You will be blessed. Job lost everything that he had, but he still worshipped God and said, "Blessed be the name of the Lord." God blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning. We must have faith, be patient and trust God. He will take care of us.

Pastor Joseph preached "Come Before Winter" from Mark 13:1-2, 6-9, 12-20 & II Timothy 4:9-13, 21. Perilous times are coming upon us. It pays each one of us not to put our salvation off until later. We all have a ministry. We need to teach against sin – teach the truth. We can't all be preachers by vocation, but we can spread this truth by living a holy life. Be diligent. Watch in all things. Some people seem religious yet don't really serve God. These people have a form of godliness, but deny the power thereof. Many have traded the eternal things for the temporary things. 
