Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Glory of Male and Female" from I Cor. 15:39-42. Everything that God made has a particular type of glory unto itself. The glory of stars is different from that of human beings, but all are glorious in their own way. We don't often think of ourselves as having a glory, but we do. Mankind's glory has been differentiated between the male and female of our kind. Individual humans start as a single cell, and then grow into many cells. This is a metaphor for mankind as a whole; what began as a single human later became a great family of billions. Just as a person's cells are all in contact and unity with each other, we are to be in contact with each other, touching and loving. Scientific studies have shown that human beings are engineered to be dependent on love. We need love to survive because "God is love" (I John 4:16) and "God created man in his own image"(Genesis 1:27). A loving man and a loving woman joined together in marriage portrays the image of God. God made humankind as a binary of sex (male and female), which means gender is also binary (masculine and feminine). The secular world is seeking to allow a legal claim to be an imagined gender other than what we truly are, but one cannot separate the mind from the body. We are created such that a man is to procreate with a woman. Imagined gender identity is legal fiction. A loving wife and husband, together, reflect the glory of God.

Pastor Joseph preached "Eye Hath Not Seen" from I Corinthians 2:9-16 & Isaiah 64:4-9, 63:1-6. The God who made this universe is just and merciful, but He is also a God of holiness, judgment, and wrath. "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23). To be free from the curse of sin, man must repent, be baptized in Jesus' name, and receive the Holy Ghost. He must then live a holy life. If we don't obey God's laws, He will chastise us, or worse, eventually judge us. The Bible was inspired by God and written by men moved by the Holy Ghost. People without the Holy Ghost can sometimes read it as being completely different than what it is intended. We need the Holy Ghost to understand the Bible. The anointing of the Holy Ghost will increase our understanding.




