Elder Lorren Godwin preached "The Importance Of The Imperative" from John 3:1-3. The basis of our relationship with God is to seek Him first in everything we do. At times we may feel that life is cruel and our troubles are trying to destroy us, but we must keep a mindset to seek Him first and to keep praise in our hearts. We must still praise Him when life is hard. God is in control of the storms of our lives. He will take care of us and see us through. Our focus must not be on wealth, knowledge, power, or other worldly things. God is the imperative. It is absolutely necessary that we focus on our relationship with God. We must be freely willing to be changed and transformed according to God's ways. We must know Him in the fellowship of His sufferings. Everything will cease but our relationship with God. Our relationship with God will last forever. Stay with Jesus!

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph taught about the Rapture from I Thessalonians 4:13-18 and other verses. The Rapture (from Latin for "catching away") of the Church will include a resurrection of dead Church Age saints, but that certainly is not the only instance of resurrection mentioned in the Scriptures. The "First Resurrection" is before the Millennial Kingdom Age, and the "General Resurrection" is afterward, just before the Great White Throne Judgment. The "First Resurrection" seemingly consists of three installments: (1) Old Testament saints (raised at Jesus' resurrection), (2) Church Age saints (raised at the Rapture), and (3) martyred Tribulation Age saints (raised at the end of the Tribulation). There are essentially three views about when the Rapture of the Church will occur: (a) Pre-Trib (before the Tribulation foretold in Revelation), or (b) Mid-Trib (during the Tribulation), or (c) Post-Trib (after the Tribulation). Pastor Joseph advocated for belief in a Pre-Tribulation Rapture, giving scriptural reasons why. He also showed support for belief in a literal, physical return of Jesus and a literal fulfillment of the foretold Millennial Kingdom Age (1,000 years), during which time the devil will be bound and the saints shall rule and reign with Jesus Christ on the earth.

Wednesday

Elder Brian Murphy Jr. preached from I Samuel 3:1-10. What keeps us awake at night? Is it thinking about things of God or the things of this world? The things of this world must not distract us. We must keep our mind focused on God because the enemy of our soul is trying to take over our thoughts. Let's seek after God. Elder Rusty Sandy preached "We Are Victorious" from I Corinthians 15:57 & Romans 8:37. Our God is not an "up and down" God. We are victorious because we serve a victorious God. Even though Daniel was thrown into a lions' den, he wasn't afraid because he knew his God was victorious. Pray and keep your eyes fastened upon Jesus. Only God can give us true victory. We serve an all-powerful God. If God is for us, who can be against us?
