He despised adultery, but refused to stone the adulteress. He even spoke to the unclean Samaritan woman at the well and offered her a way out of sin. He firmly judged the religious leaders of the day, but was kind and patient with the common folks. He chastised leaders for being overbearing, but offered a relief from burdens. His life is summed up in one word: LOVE!

Elder Les Benedum preached about both giving and receiving, in a sermon titled "I Can't." The Lord Jesus taught that, "It is more blessed to give than to receive" (see Acts 20:35). 
