Sunday AM – Religious Freedom Sunday and Sanctity of Human Life Sunday

Pastor Joseph taught a lesson on religious freedom from James 1:23-27. Our freedom of conscience (of thought) is the basis of all other freedoms, yet it is not being well respected today. The immature pitch tantrums and riot whenever someone disagrees with them. Liberty is the freedom to do what is right, against our fleshly compulsion to do wrong. Every day, every hour, we must abide in His Word and crucify our flesh. If we see something wrong within ourselves in our spiritual reflection, we must not ignore it. Take action and do something about it. We must keep ourselves unspotted from the world. Pure and undefiled religion is when we are a doer of the Word and keeps ourselves unspotted from the world.

Pastor Joseph preached “Borrowed Vessels” from II Kings 4:3, II Corinthians 4:7. We are all vessels of clay made to hold the miracles of God. He is the potter, and we are the clay (Isaiah 64:8). We should aspire to be vessels of honor, not dishonor (II Tim. 2:20-21). While it is an honor to receive a miracle being poured into us as a vessel, an even greater honor is to take part in a miracle being poured out from us into someone else—to be the ongoing source of a miracle for others, not just a recipient ourselves. Don’t let emotional pain cause you to turn away from God. Stay faithful and thankful, and God can use the pain we have suffered to make us better vessels for His purposes. God has a way of taking away our scars if we will praise and thank Him. Be a vessel of honor. We must shun vain and profane babblings and those things that lead to ungodliness. Daily, let us cleanse ourselves from dishonor that we might be vessels of honor. Stay full of the Holy Ghost. Let the rivers of living water flow out from you. Be a vessel that can be used of God.

Wednesday

Jr. Elder JT Sandy preached “Lay Down Your Stones” from John 8:1-12. We can’t throw stones (insults and accusations) at people and then in the next moment invite them to church. If you want to prove a point, do it with love. Preach the truth in love. When you are hateful, you are throwing stones. People need truth, but we must first lay down our stones. Stop looking at them as sinners and judging them by outward appearances, and start seeing them as children of God. Social media should be as a witness tool and not a war zone.
Elder Les Benedum preached “How Do You Hear?” from Luke 8:8-15. Many are called but all must hear what said. We must hear what is said to us by ministers who are rooted and grounded in God’s Word. If the Word of God convicts you, then *listen*. Are you ready to hear what God has to tell you and then do what He wants you to do? We need to encourage each other to listen to the Holy Ghost.


