Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph began a teaching series on the Ten Commandments, Ex. 20:1-17. Some of the commandments have additional wording or clarification. Three such that stand out are the third (the Lord's name), fourth (Sabbath), and fifth (honoring parents). Today's lesson focused primarily on the Third Commandment, "Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain." There is debate over what constitutes taking His name in vain. Jewish doctrine has changed over time. God's name was once spoken more freely, but eventually many Jewish people decided to not speak the name in normal use. This was perhaps due in part to cultural pressure related to Hellenization, i.e. Greek influence, which philosophy held that no one could know God's name. (Later on, Christians that interpreted Scripture through a lens of Greek philosophy began to see God as a "Holy Three" instead of the Holy One.) Dennis Prager argues that the phrase "will not hold him guiltless" means carrying God's name in vain is an unpardonable sin, and since, therefore, hellfire is the punishment, it must refer to an extreme violation of *doing evil in God's name*. While Prager correctly surmises that not all sins are equal in God's eyes, he then (in a circular reasoning) regards all "guilt" as equal, always requiring hellfire. Pastor Joseph argued for both light and heavy violations being wrong, and yet presented that God could very well possibly assign differing guilt, light and heavy.

Sunday PM

Pastor Doug Joseph preached "Solid Rock" from Matthew 7:24-27, 16:13-19, II Timothy 2:19, and II Peter 1:19. The Word of God has been revealed to mankind and confirmed by God through signs, wonders, and miracles. God's revealed truth is the "sure foundation" upon which the Church of Jesus Christ is built. Part of that foundation is the revealed truth that Jesus is the promised Messiah—God manifested in flesh for our salvation. Jesus confirmed this crucial revelation to Peter in Matthew 16, referring to it as a rock upon which He would build His church, "and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." Because of the revealed truth of God's Word, we know that Jesus is coming back again and we must be ready. This is why we seek to live right, walking in holiness and purity.

Wednesday

Sis. Adena Joseph preached on being available for encounters with God, using John 1:9-12. We should never pass up an encounter with God. He will give us power if we believe on His name. Always be ready to say "Yes, Lord."
Elder Hannah Sandy preached about God's judgment of all mankind in eternity from Nahum 1:2-10. God is supremely just, and He will punish all wicked souls. There will be no excuses for sin. Jesus is coming soon. It may even be today or tomorrow. Those who are not ready will receive the judgment of God. We must prepare for His coming and not be like those in the days of Noah, who rejected the truth and were all destroyed. If your name isn't in the Book of Life on Judgment Day, you will be cast into a "lake of fire." Eternity is forever! Please, get ready!


Fun! Kids Corner "Good Samaritan" – hidden things puzzle
