The church is not successful because of our gifting, personality traits, or interpersonal skills, but rather because of the anointing of God. When there is unity, the anointing flows from one vessel to another just as the oil of anointing flowed down Aaron's beard and clothing (Psalm 133). It's possible for older saints & preachers to pass a mantle of God's anointing to others in future generations. Jesus is building His church upon the "rock" of divine revelation of truth that He is the Messiah, "and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it" (Matthew 16:18). The church is built by Jesus, the Anointed One, upon the foundation of Jesus Christ and His Apostles. When Jesus ascended into heaven He left the church in the hands of trained men who were anointed when the Holy Ghost fell on the Day of Pentecost. Great power came upon the disciples. Others who saw them took notice that they "had been with Jesus" (Acts 4:13). Peter was used in pouring the anointing on others, and then they poured it out on still more. That same anointing is on our church today. The anointing is powerful. When two or three agree on anything, it shall be done. We can have a breakthrough. We need to pray, fast, be faithful to church, and witness. Keep praying and believing for a breakthrough. "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved" (Romans 10:13).
