Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph continued our series on the Ten Commandments, from Exodus 20:1-17. Today's lesson focused on the command to not commit adultery, but first we discussed which commandment is the foundation for all others: It's the first one: "I am the Lord thy God...." Jesus was asked which commandment is the greatest. He answered with Deut. 6:4, which is essentially like the first commandment. There is only one God, and He created the entire cosmos, He's the God of His people, and the only source of absolute truth. Only God objectively defines right and wrong. Jesus said the second greatest command is to love our neighbor as ourselves. This is the summary of not only the Ten Commandments but also all of the Law of God. If we love God and love people, we will keep God's laws. God made woman from Adam's side so that she was to be beside him, not above or underneath. Before God ever told mankind to be holy or just, He told them to be fruitful and multiply. Marriage is the oldest institution in human history. It is intended to create families and nurture children. Our relationship to God comes first, then our spouse. then our children, then the church and then other people. Adultery is a term for any sin against a marriage vow. It's often confused with fornication (sexual sin), but adultery can include minor or major sins against a marriage vow, and might not include sex (for example, mere lust can be adultery). The command to honor one's father and mother is a life-long duty, not just during one's childhood.

Pastor Joseph preached "Hide And Seek" from John 12:36, 42-46 & Matthew 6:22-24, 33, and Luke 15. Jesus told three parables of lost things: a lost sheep, a lost coin, and a wayward son. The sheep knew it was lost but did not know the way home, so the shepherd sought it. The lost coin didn't know it was lost, and the woman sought diligently until she found it. The wayward son *knew the way home*, so his father didn't seek him, but waited for the son to decide to return. When the son did, the father saw him coming and ran to embrace him. Don't arrogantly demand the church or God must come seeking you, when you know the way. Determine to seek God with all your heart. Yet for lost souls who don't know the way home, we are to be a light in this world that can lead them to God.

Wednesday

Elder Brian Murphy preached "Beauty, Not Ashes" from Genesis 1:1-25. When God created everything, He said, "It is good" or "It was worth it." Adam sinned; thus the sin curse came upon men, God looked down through the ages and made a way for mankind. God was manifested in the flesh. Jesus lived His life, and then gave His life on Calvary that all men could be saved. Jesus considered that the agony, grief, and pain to be endured ... was all worth it. He will give us "beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, and the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness" (Isaiah 61:3). Although it cost Him His life. He felt it was worth it. He loved us that much!


