#### Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught a lesson titled "Millennial Temple" from Zech. 14:1-16 and other passages. The Bible not only prophesies that a Jewish Temple will be rebuilt, but indicates that sacrifices will take place in it—during the Millennial Kingdom age. Because our Christian New Covenant involves communion with fruit of the vine and unleavened bread, *instead of sacrifices*, many Christians are opposed to future sacrifices in a Jewish Temple, thinking it would disrespect Jesus' sacrifice on the cross. Still, sacrifices are foretold. Given that God chose to allow sacrifices to foreshadow His crucifixion in the past, it is not impossible for Him to choose to allow future sacrifices to memorialize His crucifixion. Whenever Bible prophecy does not make sense to us, we still should trust that God's word will come to pass, and allow that God can do as He wills. Pastor Joseph also gave a quick study of the Jewish Feasts that God commanded through Moses: Passover, Unleavened Bread, First Fruits, Pentecost, Trumpets, Atonement, and Tabernacles. Each feast either has corresponded, or will correspond, to a major New Testament event— Jesus died on the Feast of Passover, was buried during the Feast of Unleavened Bread, resurrected at the Feast of First Fruits, and the Church was birthed in Acts 2 on the Feast of Pentecost. Some scholars anticipate that the upcoming Rapture will correspond with the Feast of Trumpets, the Tribulation period will correspond with the Feast of Atonement, and the Millennial Kingdom Age will correspond with the Feast of Tabernacles.

## Sunday PM

The youth presented a skit titled "Does Anyone Hear Her?" The skit was touching and powerful. In our daily lives, do we realize that people are watching us and silently calling out for help? Wherever you may go, McDonald's, Wal-Mart, or even a car lot, know that lost souls there are hungry for the Word of God and desire what we have. Be sensitive to the Spirit of God at all times. There was an indescribable, powerful move of the Spirit as souls sought God.

### Wednesday

Elder Kieran Joseph preached "Green Wood" from Exodus 32:1-7. When the people of Israel committed idolatry in making a golden calf, Moses pitched the Tabernacle far away; the presence of God will be taken from us if we allow anything to become more important than God. Later on, Moses smote the rock although had commanded him to speak to it, and thus he did not get to see the promised land. We should obey God 100%. We must not be green wood, but obey. Sis. Hannah Sandy preached "Compassion" from Matthew 25:31-46. We must have compassion for people around us. Jesus told us to go to the lost, those who have nothing, and love them as He did. People all around us need help. We should not neglect to show kindness. We should not be too busy and just walk by people. We need to slow down and see broken people, and show kindness and help them. We ought to love both God and our neighbor.


