Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph continued our ongoing series on the "Ten Commandments" from Exodus 20:1-21. We are to have no other gods except the True God. His command against idols not only prohibits making an image/icon/statue unto a false god, but we're also forbidden from making any icon for the True God. False religions made such idols and literally bowed to them. However, if one puts anything as a higher priority than God, he/she is an idolater. The man Christ Jesus is the express image of the invisible God, meaning He's the exact icon or perfect representation. The only true God was and is manifested in Jesus the Messiah. "God was in Christ reconciling the world unto Himself." If there is any other identity than God being worshipped, it is idolatry. The command to "honour thy father and mother" does not abate just because one grows up and leaves home. It is a lifelong obligation. If you're not taking care of your father and your mother, you are not honouring them. "Thou shalt not kill" would be better translated as "not murder." Not all killing is murder. Capital punishment (instituted by God) and self-defense are not murder.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Blood" from Isaiah 1:18 & Hebrews 9:11-14. God built some amazing technology into living things. Blood is literally a liquid organ, very complex in its design and function. It carries energy to different parts of our body. Blood cells fight disease. It carries oxygen from our heart and lungs. Life is in the blood. God is a speaking God, a God of self-revelation, who is beneficent and a God of mercy and love, though also Holy. He's a God who makes a way where there is no way. "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord" (Isaiah 55:8). God couldn't find any man who was worthy enough to take away the sins of the world. So He overshadowed Mary and she brought forth Jesus, the Saviour of all men. Jesus was without sin and went to the cross of Calvary and died that we could be saved. It was His precious blood, His pure blood that saved us! Jesus didn't have to die for His sins. He had not sins of His own. Jesus was the perfect sacrifice. Oh, the precious blood of Jesus!

Wednesday

Elder Matt Anderson preached from Luke 18:9-14 about being sold out completely to God, including being careful not to make excuses (which are not really excuses) for letting down on our prayer life and dedication in study of God's Word. Faithfulness is not just beneficial; it is essential to staying healthy spiritually. Elder Les Benedum preached from Isaiah 55:10-11 about being faithful to sow the seed of God's word in whatsoever field the Lord has ordained for us and to which He has appointed us. At the time of our calling, the field seems wonderful and manageable from a distance, but when we get on site, the field seems hard, harsh, huge and beyond hope of a successful harvest. Even when we finally sow seed across the length, there is temptation to doubt, but just because we don't see results does not mean nothing is happening. Stay faithful! God will give the increase!



He said to them, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these." Mark 10:14b (NIV)






