Elder Les Benedum preached "The Mark" from Revelation 13:11-18. We don't need a statue or image of Jesus to let people know that we serve Him. We put a mark on our lives by the way we live. Wicked people think and do ungodly things. "For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he: Eat and drink, saith he to thee; but his heart is not with thee" (Proverbs 23:7). Our mind is where we get our ideas. What we think about and focus on, we eventually start doing. What is our mind focused on? A mark can be more than a number on forehead or hands. The mark of a man can be what he says and does. The mark of a Christian can be hearing God speak to go pray for someone and obeying; laying hands on someone—the mark of a Christian is one who hears from God and then obeys. What mark is on you?

Elder Lorren Godwin preached "When A Grasshopper Becomes A Giant" from Numbers 13:32-33. When Moses sent people into the land of Canaan, he didn't tell them to worry about the people. He told them that God had given them that land. They came back feeling defeated and said that, "We are as grasshoppers to these giants." When God speaks to us and tells us that the land is ours, we shouldn't worry; just go possess. We aren't supposed to worry about what people are going to think of us. We are supposed to go preach the gospel, teach a Bible study, or do other work of God. People worry about issues, burdens of life, and things that don't matter to God. Too many people want to talk about negative things. When Samson told Delilah the truth about his hair, he let the grasshopper become a giant. Don't let the devil trick you. Don't let your past become a giant. Step out by faith and invite someone to church. Just because they didn't come last time doesn't mean you're a failure. If we will continue to sow and reap, God will reward us. We must trust God in all things. God told us to give. So, are we going to let this grasshopper become our giant? Don't worry about the results. Obey and trust God.
