Resurrection Sunday — AM service

Pastor Joseph preached “Risen” from Luke 24:1-10. The resurrection of Jesus Christ is actual history. It happened! The tomb is empty! Jesus is alive! “For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved” (John 3:17). Jesus purchased salvation for people. Sinners of the vilest sorts can find forgiveness with Jesus Christ. The Bible has been the most beneficial document in history for elevating the status of women. The Lord chose women to be the first to see the risen Christ, and first to carry the message of His resurrection. Next to angels, women preached first the message that “He is not here. He is risen” (see Luke 24:1-10, Matthew 28:1-10). We can and should rejoice continually in the resurrection—not just at Easter time. Just as we are to “pray without ceasing,” we are also to “rejoice evermore.” You can live your life celebrating that He is not in the tomb; He is risen! We serve a risen Savior!

Resurrection Sunday — PM service

Pastor Joseph preached “Lessons From Jourdon’s Crossing” from John 3:1-8; 5:6-17. Being born again is not the final goal, but rather is an entry gate; the beginning of one’s journey of serving the Lord. When you begin this journey, you must turn away from sin, hell, and darkness, and turn to the Lord, the church, righteousness and holiness. In the journey we face trials and temptations. After the Israelites crossed over the Jordan River, they faced battle of conquest against wicked, ungodly people. We also must be careful of the ungodly influences we let in our lives. Stand and live a holy life for God. Jourdon Anderson was formerly a slave, set free by union soldiers. His old master later wrote to him, asking him to return. Pastor read aloud Jourdon’s letter of reply to his wicked former master. He laid out three lessons from it: (1) When you’ve been set free, don’t even think about going back. (2) If you aren’t free yet, get out from under sin and let the Lord free you by the power of His blood. (3) Don’t dwell on the past. Pivot toward the future. Don’t live your life dwelling on the scars of your past. Reject the victim mentality!

Wednesday

Elder Kieran Joseph preached “The Cost Of Discipleship” from Matthew 8:16-22. We cannot surround ourselves with worldly influences and environment without it affecting our walk with God. If we are going to follow Jesus we must lay down worldly pleasures. We must take up our cross and follow Jesus. He must come first in our lives. A cost of discipleship is self-denial; keeping one’s flesh in subjection. Elder Hannah Sandy preached “Running The Race” from Hebrews 12:1 & I Corinthians 9:24-25. We must run this race with patience. While running this race we must maintain a close relationship with God. We must remain faithful to Him no matter what obstacle we face. Are we running a race worthy of eternal life? We must live our lives committed to God. Pray daily, read your Bibles—be involved in godly affairs. Take steps necessary to prepare yourself for crossing the finish!


