Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph launched a survey of The Book of Acts of the Apostles. This first lesson covered Acts 1:1-11. The book's title attributes the actions to human disciples, but it's clear the disciples were filled with, guided by, and empowered by the Holy Ghost. So, it's the Acts of the Spirit-filled Apostles. Their deeds cannot be viewed as distinct from the will and help of God. Jesus commanded those who had seen Him depart to go to Jerusalem and wait for the promise of the Father. To all those who believe, God will work on their behalf. All they need do is wait for Him. God wants to work for us, to bestow kindness and grace. He loves to bless and help us. God poured Himself into the disciples. His Spirit gave them power. They went forth after they received the Holy Ghost and were witnesses for Him. Many souls were added to the church. God is our loving Father, who desires to work for us. We should anticipate all that God will do for us. "For since the beginning of the world men have not heard, nor perceived by the ear, neither hath the eve seen. O God, beside thee, what he hath prepared for him that waiteth for him" (Isaiah 64:4). God gave a new covenant and wrote His law in our hearts so we would be a regenerated people. After God works for us, we should spread His gospel to other souls. Let others know the God who loves to work in us!

Bro. Jacob Sutton preached "If You Don't Use It, You'll Lose It" from II Kings 4: 4-6. Pastor Joseph preached "Sorry, Not Sorry" from II Corinthians 7:8-10. There are both a godly sorrow and a worldly sorrow. Godly sorrow brings repentance (a change of heart and life), which leads to salvation. Worldly sorrow may bring tears, but it brings no real change. "For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death" (II Corinthians 7:10). A person with godly sorrow desires to turn from sin. "I am weary with my groaning; all the night make I my bed to swim; I water my couch with my teats" (Psalm 6:6). A person grieved in heart turns from their sin. Teach your children what "thus saith the Lord." This is necessary because the world is waiting to indoctrinate them. Teach them the truth.

Wednesday

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "There Is No Limit" from II Kings 13:18. The greatness of God is beyond man's thinking. Yet we may limit in our own minds what God can do by disobeying His Word. We thus limit God if we don't pray, witness, and obey the commandments of God. Trust God and remove all limits! Elder J.T. Sandy preached "Keep The Enemy Where He Belongs" from Ephesians 1:19-23 & Romans 16:20. We have power within us if we have received the Holy Ghost. It is time for us to fight. We can't live by the standards of the world. Stand up to the devil and tell him, "It is written," as Jesus did. We must obey the commandments of God. The devil has to flee when we have the power of God working in our lives. The place the devil belongs, is under our feet!
