Sunday AM – Spanish-English revival

Rev. Mauricio Mena preached from Matthew 22:3. Jesus taught a parable of a king who arranged a marriage celebration for his son, and he sent forth servants to call invited guests to the wedding, yet they would not come. In the parable, the king represented God, the son represented the Messiah (Jesus, the man), and the invited guests who declined to attend symbolically represented those of Israel (Judaism) who reject the Messiah, Jesus. This symbolic meaning did not escape the notice of Jewish leaders at that time (see Matthew 22:15). Yet the parable records (vv 9-10) that the king then sent his servants "into the highways" to invite "as many as ye shall find... to the marriage. So those servants went out into the highways, and gathered together all as many as they found, <u>both bad and good</u>: and the wedding was furnished with guests." This refers to God welcoming Gentile (non-Jewish) people into the Kingdom of God, during the Church Age (aka Dispensation of Grace). Don't make the mistake of being too busy to accept God's offer!!

Sunday PM – Spanish-English revival

Rev. Mauricio Mena preached from Matthew 24:34-35. There is power in the name of Jesus. Tomorrow is not promised to us, yet we have an opportunity to rejoice in the Lord today. The world didn't give us our joy, peace, and love, thus the world can't take it away. Hallelujah! Jesus gave prophetic clues about the end-time generation that would witness His return. We must daily live ready, for the trumpet may sound today. Heaven and earth shall pass away, but God's word shall not pass away. God has not forgotten the promise He made to *you*. Only believe. God gave water from a rock in the desert, for Moses and the people. They had only to believe. "Ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you" (Acts 1:8). Believe and you shall receive the Holy Ghost. It's a promise! It's freely available; only believe. God promised us power upon receiving the Holy Ghost. Do you believe? If you aren't happy with your life, then why? Is your life a disaster? There's a promise knocking at your door. One does not know what he or she is "looking for" until finding Jesus. He'll give us peace, joy, and love we've never known. The promise is yours to claim.

Jesus is the chief cornerstone. Our lives must line up to God's Word. Get back to the basics.


