Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "God's Law of Love" from I John 4:8. God is love. "Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law" (Romans 13:10). Pastor Joseph read some of the preface of "The Remedy." When God built the universe, He built it to operate within His own harmony of love. An example of this is respiration: when we breathe we give the plants carbon dioxide, and in return they give us oxygen. We should similarly be willing to exchange things of value with our neighbors and, and they should likewise also be giving. Love is giving, not selfish. Love does no harm to his neighbor. Don't intentionally hurt or humiliate people. Humiliation is an act that is done to someone that causes harm, often lifelong. People in power can humiliate those under them, even without realizing it. If you have power over anyone, be careful of this. Show love to one another. "For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself" (Galatians 5:14). "If ye fulfill the royal law according to the scripture; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well" (James 2:8).

Missionary Fonzell Marsh preached "Surrendering to the Spirit of Worship" from I Chronicles 16:29 & John 4:21-24. The way we get God's attention is to magnify and praise His name. God has called us to be holy and separate from other people. If we do not worship God in spirit and in truth, God has no obligation to us. We must get to the place where we will surrender and submit to the Spirit of God. When we truly surrender to worship, then the glory of God will be revealed in us. Worship is continually knowing who He is. He's our Provider, our Protector, the Great I Am, He's our All in All. Worship should be our lifestyle. It gives us power and protection. We should reflect God's glory. We were nobody, just dirt balls, but God came and gave His life for us! Oh, just stand in awe of Him! 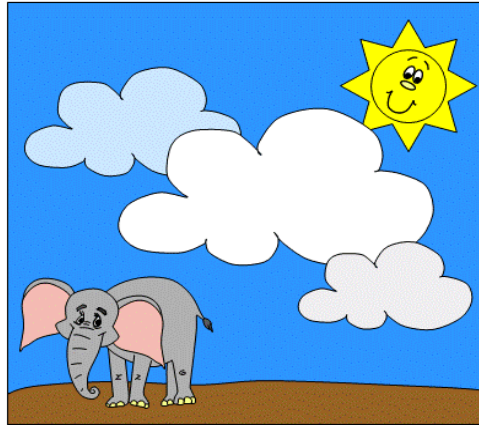

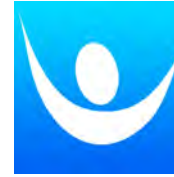
