Sunday AM – continuing our Survey of the Book of Acts

Pastor Joseph taught an expository lesson from Acts 14, titled “Finishing Strong.” In a prior lesson from Acts 13, Paul and Barnabas began their first missionary journey, which was completed in Acts 14. Everywhere they went there was either revival or riot, or both. Their policy was that salvation was first preached to the Jews, then to Gentiles. When Jews rejected it, he would turn to the Gentiles. Although some Jews believed, others stirred up opposition. The apostles continued speaking boldly for the Lord. God added special signs and miracles to back up their preaching. When you preach doctrine and then God performs miracles by your hands, it causes people to pay attention to your doctrine. Yet people are very fickle. During this journey, they were viciously opposed, then almost worshipped as gods, and finally opposed again, including Paul being stoned and left for dead. Paul got up and went right back to preaching, even visiting the same cities where those who stoned him were from. He was undaunted and finished strong, even in the face of horrific persecution. Let us pray that God grants us such strength.

Pastor Joseph preached “The Abundance Of The Heart” from Luke 6:45. The biblical concept of the heart is one’s innermost thoughts—the real you. What you really treasure indicates your values & true self, and will eventually be revealed in words & actions. If your heart is filled with discord, then your mouth will be filled with gossip. If your heart is filled with ingratitude, then your mouth will be filled with complaining. Yet if your heart is filled with admiration for God, your mouth will be fill with praise. We ought to control our tongue, yet it requires true self-discipline (control of one’s spirit). Since we cannot truly know our own heart, and cannot fix our own heart, we must allow God to fix us. He’s the Great Physician and will give you a new heart. Even if you have had a “heart transplant,” you ought to come back to Him for a check-up and be renewed in the Holy Ghost.

Elder Brian Murphy Jr. preached “Pressure, Pain, Perfection” from Matthew 6:9. When you start living for God there’s going to be pressure. You have two choices: to stay committed to God and serve Him wholeheartedly or to give up. And then there’s the pain we must go through when we feel that all of hell is fighting us. We can reach out to the body (the church) to gain strength. That is why it is so important that the body is in unity. If the church is ever going to have revival, it must have unity. There’s pressure, there’s pain, but at the end of our life there’s perfection!
Elder Charles Hoskins preached from Mark 14:3-8. A woman broke an alabaster box of expensive ointment and anointed Jesus with it. She loved Him and did this for His burial. She was maligned as wasteful, but true worship is never a waste!
