Elder Lorren Godwin preached "From The Inside" from Psalm 139:23-24. The trouble with some people is that they procrastinate about and ignore things that are wrong inside. We need to pray for the Lord to search our hearts and see if there's anything wrong. When we know there's a problem, we need to take care of it right away. If we don't, it may fester and grow into something big. Be very careful because these little problems can make you lose out spiritually and backslide. Our thoughts can destroy us. One simple "innocent" thought can become a huge infection. We've got to be careful what grows inside of our hearts and minds. Stray thoughts can totally destroy us. Keep up your prayer life. The devil will send us thoughts of various reasons not to pray. Without prayer it's so easy to be tempted to sin. We've got to lay aside the sins that so easily beset us. When we go into battle, let us take the name of Jesus with us. He will help us defeat the problems that come from within.

Pastor Joseph preached "Wait On The Lord" from Psalm 27:14 & Isaiah 40:31. We may think our fellow is a tare, while he or she may be wheat, or even just chaff. Tares (detrimental weeds) and chaff (non-detrimental husk of the usable grain) are not the same at all. One may think he can rightly judge who is wheat, tares, or chaff, but only the Lord can make such a judgment, and His word declares that the chaff and the tares are not to be separated from the wheat until harvest time (symbolic of the day of judgment). We look on the outward, while God alone sees hearts. We may be derailed by our emotions, but God is always the righteous judge. It is not our place to judge that which only God can judge. God will not settle a matter on your time schedule but on His, and this requires waiting on Him. If we are planted on the Rock, we will not be "moved" (shaken unto falling).

Wednesday


