Sunday AM

Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Just Keep Praising Him" from Acts 16:25. The time to praise God is not just after the victory. The time to praise God is not just when the battle is over. The time to praise God is not just when He's done great things in your life. The time to praise God is *all the time*. When we go out to battle we don't have to relent and be scared but be strong in the Lord. Go out praising and worshipping God. Trust Him and He will give you victory. Jesus said that we would have tribulation in this life but we must keep an attitude of praise and worship. Life is just life and it's so much easier to face battles when we worship and praise God. Paul and Silas didn't sit in prison and grumble and complain. They prayed and sang praises to God. There is something powerful about worshipping and praising God in dire circumstances. They walked out of the prison as free men. We praise God for what He's done and we worship Him because He is God. Just keep praising God in spite of any situation you may face.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Choice" from Joshua 24:15. In each dispensation God gave a way to be saved, and a different barrier against sinning, but in each dispensation, most of mankind wasted and ruined it. First came conscience, then government, patriarchal (family structure) covenant, and law. The New Covenant is better than the Old. We have the blood of Jesus rather than the blood of bulls and goats. We have a better high priest in Jesus than they had under the Old Covenant. Yet one day this covenant is going to come to an end in Great Tribulation. By God's choice, humans are free moral agents. Why did God select Abram? God said why: "he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the Lord, to do justice and judgment" (Genesis 18:19). Family authority *commands*—children aren't old enough to "choose you this day whom you will serve!" As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord!

Wednesday

Elder JT Sandy preached "The Pit" from Genesis 37:3-4, 11-14, 18-24. Every time you almost feel like giving up, there a point to it. Every time you're in a dark pit in your life, there's a reason why. You may not understand why. It may affect many people. Yet troubles will not last. Joy comes in the morning. God is with you in the pit and will bring you out! Joseph had ups and downs in his life, but he was able to save his family and a whole nation, solely because he was in a pit! When you find yourself in a pit, trust in God. God's mercies are forever.

Elder Baron Claypool preached "The Difference Between Marching and Marking Time" from Numbers 14:34. We can have what God promised us. The difference between marching and marking time is that you move when you march and you just march in place when you mark time. Don't be satisfied by staying in one place. If you want what God has promised you, march forward and claim it.

There He made time to talk to a Samaritan woman. He waited for her, although she had no idea Who was sitting on her well. The Lord has been waiting on us all, just "sitting on our well." Two were water baptized in Jesus name: Ken Lamoureux and Zoey Grace Parker. Brother Ken was gloriously baptized with the Holy Ghost while still in the water. **Sat. Sept. 23** –Elder Baron Claypool preached "A Change In the Atmosphere" from John chapters 11 and 12. Lazarus, the friend of Jesus, was dead so long his body stank, as our situations sometimes do. The Lord changed death to life. Later, in the next chapter of John's gospel, Mary, the sister of Lazarus, anointed Jesus' feet with precious ointment of spikenard, "and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment" — just as our worship can change the whole atmosphere around us!

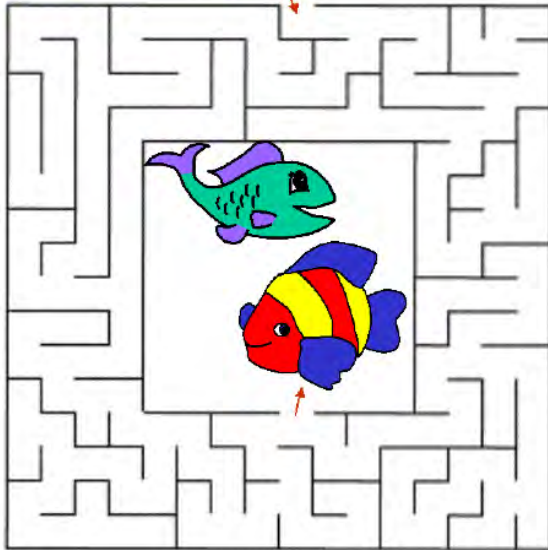
