### Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph continued our Survey of Acts with the "Council of Acts 15" (vv. 19-21). Paul and Barnabas had planted churches with success in reaching Gentiles (non-Jews). Eventually, an unavoidable issue reached critical mass: are Gentile converts to be required to keep all the Mosaic Law, including circumcision, the essential token of the Jewish Covenant? Are Gentiles part of what is merely a new "iteration" of the Mosaic Covenant, and thus accountable to all the ceremonial laws, rituals, festivals, Sabbaths, etc, or are they converts to the New Covenant in a way that is distinct from the Mosaic Covenant? Some Jewish believers said that Gentile believers had to be circumcised and keep all the Mosaic Law to be saved. Paul, Barnabas, and Peter led opposition to that viewpoint. With help from James, the half-brother of Jesus, and a willingness to compromise on some aspects of the Mosaic law, they united the fledgling sect of Christianity on this crucial issue. Certain portions of the Mosaic Law were recommended for Gentiles to keep: don't eat food offered to pagan gods (later sold in the markets), don't eat blood or meat killed without draining the blood, and avoid all sexual sin (fornication).

### Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Keep On Keeping On" from Hebrews 12:1-4. We must be determined to live for God day by day, to be faithful to church, to read our Bible, to fast and pray. If we're ever tested to lose our life because of our faith in God, we must be willing, but we also must "give our life away" by living for Him day by day. Time is passing quickly. We're in the midst of a golden opportunity. This is no time to be weary in well doing. The church is in the *people* business. We've all had our problems; we're just people who have been wounded, but who are thankful for God's grace and mercy. We must keep on keeping on. "Let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not" (Galatians 6:9). Persistence means keeping on even when prayers seem fruitless. It means keeping on even on when life is tough. The cause is just! Just keep on keeping on!

### Wednesday

Elder JT Sandy preached "Knock, Knock, Who's There?" from Revelation 3:15-16, 19-20. We must hear from God before we make an important decision in our lives. Hearing is easy but listening is harder. This world is offering us so many pleasures. Who are we going to listen to: the world or Jesus? No man can serve two masters. God must be the main priority in our lives. When He knocks we must let nothing keep us from answering His call.  
Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Silence Is Not Deadly" from Psalm 23:4. The world has technology—television, radios, computers, iPads, etc—a cacophony of voices that can drown out the Lord's voice if we are not careful. If the Lord speaks to us and we keep ignoring Him, we can lose out. The world tries to get our attention, but we must use caution and listen to the voice of God.

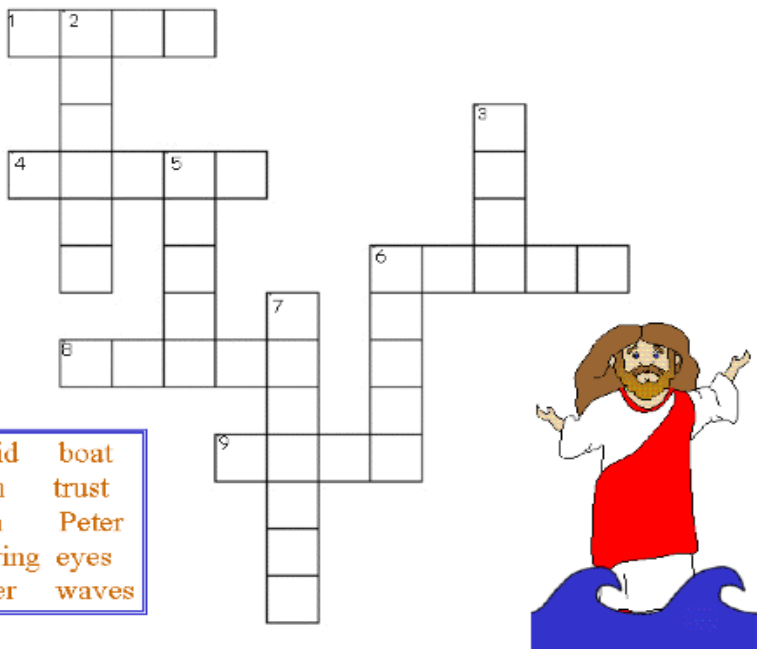

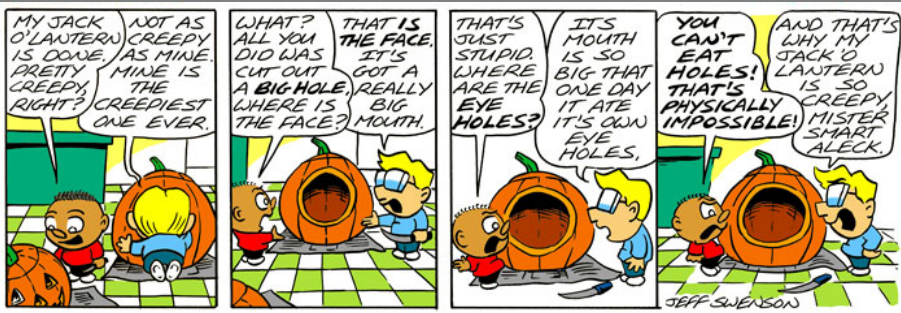
